The researchers examined the genetic diversity of modern and ancient Emperor penguin populations in Antarctica to estimate how they have changed over the last 30, years and found that only three populations may have survived during this cold period. The main challenge the Emperor penguins faced during the last ice age was that there was twice as much sea ice compared to current Antarctic conditions and so the distance from the open ocean, where the penguins feed, to the stable sea ice where they breed was probably too far. The three populations that did survive may have done so by breeding near polynyas, which are areas of the ocean kept free to sea ice by wind and currents. One polynya that supported an Emperor penguin population throughout the last ice age was likely to be in the Ross Sea. The emperor population larger that thought In a recent study, international researchers have found that there are twice as many Emperor penguins in Antarctica as previously thought. This discovery was made by researchers using high-resolution satellite mapping technology, which provides scientists with an important benchmark for monitoring future Emperor penguin populations. The satellite images allowed researchers to locate emperor penguins using their dark brown guano stains and by zooming in they could identify individual penguins. From the images the researchers counted , birds which is double the previous estimate of ,, birds. In addition, because the penguins in their black and white fur stand out from the white snow it meant the scientists could also easily count the numbers of Emperor penguin colonies across Antarctica. In fact, the team found 44 colonies around the coast of Antarctica, with seven previously unknown. Previously, it was believed that Emperor penguins retain their body heat because of their thick plumage and layers of fat, however, it has been found that they keep their heat because the surface of their feathers are colder than the surrounding air. Using thermal imaging on the penguins in Adelie Land, the scientists found that the surface temperature of the birds were four degrees cooler than the surrounding air. The only parts of

On 11 February, the coronation for Zewditu took place. She pledged to rule justly through her Regent, Tafari. While Tafari was the more visible of the two, Zewditu was far from an honorary ruler. Her position required that she arbitrate the claims of competing factions. In other words, she had the last word. Tafari carried the burden of daily administration but, because his position was relatively weak, this was often an exercise in futility for him. Initially his personal army was poorly equipped, his finances were limited, and he had little leverage to withstand the combined influence of the Empress, the Minister of War, or the provincial governors. Also, during this time, he survived the flu pandemic, having come down with the illness. The primary goal of the trip to Europe was for Ethiopia to gain access to the sea. Although patterning many reforms after European models, Tafari remained wary of European pressure. To guard against economic imperialism, Tafari required that all enterprises have at least partial local ownership. That is at once a benefit and a misfortune. He was accompanied by Seyum Mangasha and Hailu Tekle Haymanot who, like Tafari, were sons of generals who contributed to the victorious war against Italy a quarter-century earlier at the Battle of Adwa. Those who were to take part in the sea-fight were condemned criminals, and each side had fifty ships, one part being styled "Rhodians" and the other "Sicilians. He and Agrippina presided, the one in a gorgeous military cloak, the other — not far distant — in a Greek mantle of cloth of gold. The battle, though one of criminals [sontes], was contested with the spirit and courage of freemen; and, after much blood had flowed, the combatants were exempted from destruction [occidioni]. As far as we know, the only time this phrase was used was at an event staged by Claudius. There are a few dubious claims regarding popular perceptions of the life and death of Napoleon Bonaparte. Despite the legend, he wasn't -- at five-foot-six -- particularly short.

Then I have cheered as, every single time, he emerged unscathed and usually stronger than before. The night he defeated that poisonous sack of venom will always be one of the most joyous, memorable moments of my life. But that was really just the beginning of the war. He always leaves us wondering; never quite sure of him. At times Trump seems volatile. Sometimes he seems distressingly inarticulate. I never know where I stand with this man or where he stands with me, us. I have never before in my life had the experience of actually caring this much about a President. In the past I basically thought people who rooted for politicians were suckers and fools. I like the guy a lot. And I want him to succeed. At first, it seemed like a dumb move at least a vulgar misstep. What was he thinking? And Trump also forced a national dialogue on the issue: Why are we taking people who are stupid, ignorant, unskilled, and need public assistance?
