B B B Bond, whose full name is Benjamin Barney Butler Bond, was born in Baltimore Co., MD. He came to Ohio (Tyler) Co. in or with his parents. His father purchased acres 28 January on Middle Island Creek near Centerville. He is the son of Benjamin Bond, Jr. and Nancy Ann Barney.

Recent evidence indicates that he was a second cousin of William B. During his senior year he led a student protest against the poor food served at the college and the obligation of students to attend class in bad weather. He and a number of other students, perhaps the entire senior class, were expelled. Bonham took up the study of law and began practicing in Pendleton, South Carolina, in In , during the nullification crisis, Bonham served as an aide to South Carolina governor James Hamilton, a position that brought him the rank of lieutenant colonel. At the same time he served as captain of a Charleston artillery company. By October he was practicing law in Montgomery, Alabama. On October 17, , he led a rally of support for the Texan cause at the Shakespeare Theater in Mobile. Three days later he was elected by citizens of Mobile to carry their resolutions of support to Sam Houston. In another two weeks he was organizing a volunteer company, the Mobile Grays , for service in Texas. Bonham reached Texas in November and quickly involved himself in political and military affairs. On December 1, , he wrote to Sam Houston from San Felipe volunteering his services for Texas and declining all pay, lands, or rations in return. On December 20, , he was commissioned a second lieutenant in the Texas cavalry, but apparently was not assigned to any specific unit. He had time to set up a law practice in Brazoria and was advertising the fact in the Telegraph and Texas Register by January 2, Courtesy of Dreanna L. Bonham and Houston quickly developed a mutual admiration. Blount of North Carolina be granted a commission as a captain in the Texas cavalry. On January 11, , Houston recommended to James W. On January 26 he was appointed one of a committee of seven to draft a preamble and resolutions on behalf of the garrison in support of Governor Henry Smith. On February 1 he was an unsuccessful candidate in the election of delegates to represent the Bexar garrison at the Texas constitutional convention. He was sent by Travis to obtain aid for the garrison at Bexar on or about February 16, Williamson assuring Travis that help was on its way and urging him to hold out. Bonham died in the battle of the Alamo on March 6, He is believed to have died manning one of the cannons in the interior of the Alamo chapel. A tomb that purportedly holds the ashes of those killed at the Alamo, including James Bonham, although its authenticity has been doubted. He has often been portrayed as a colonel and one of the commanders of the Alamo garrison. He is called "Colonel" by Travis in two letters from the Alamo, but this was only a title of respect dating back to his days with the South Carolina militia. He was present sporadically at the Alamo. In the Texas Centennial Commission erected a statue of Bonham on the courthouse square of the town of Bonham, named in his honor. Marriage Bonds - Explanatory The following marriages were taken from original bonds on file in the office of Judge of Court of Ordinary. The pages given refer to Minutes of Inferior Court - I which a few were copied. The law to record marriages in Georgia was not passed till Hence there were no actual returns prior to that date. Before forms were not used, all were written out, usually by the groom, seldom by the Register of Probate. The writing is still remarkably clear in nearly every instance. John, Ashel and Jason are known to have been, probably Thomas and one of the Wm. From to only sixty five marriages were recorded in the first book. Evidently the new law did not seem important, or the slowness and dangers of travel discouraged its application. These marriages are published in Vol. Joseph Habersham Historical Collections.
