She is state Rep. A corrected version of the story is below: Feds seeking approval to pursue death penalty U. Attorney Scott Brady says federal prosecutors are seeking approval to pursue the death penalty against Pittsburgh synagogue shooting suspect Robert Bowers. Brady says multiple search warrants have been issued in the investigation of Bowers, a long-haul trucker who worked as an independent contractor. Police responding to the shooting at the Tree of Life synagogue wounded Bowers and arrested him. Bowers is scheduled to appear in court early Monday afternoon for a hearing. Bernice and Sylvan Simon were always ready to help others, and "they always did it with a smile. Eighty-six-year-old Sylvan Simon was a retired accountant with a good sense of humor, the kind of person his former rabbi felt comfortable joking with after Sylvan Simon broke his arm a couple of weeks ago. Bernice Simon was a former nurse. Neighbors say the year-old loved classical music and devoted time to charitable work. Emeritus Rabbi Alvin Berkun says both Simons were "an active, steady," and devoted presence at Tree of Life synagogue. The couple was among those massacred Saturday at the temple, where the Simons married in a candlelight ceremony in At least 2, mourners packed Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Hall in Pittsburgh and thousands more stood outside at a vigil for the 11 who were killed during Sabbath services at a Pittsburgh synagogue. Tree of Life Rabbi Jeffrey Myers said he began services at 9: He said there were 12 in the sanctuary at the time, most sitting in the back. But, alas, I had eight people in the back. My holy place has been defiled. We will continue to thrive and sing and worship and learn together. Mourners sang and prayed together. Others held lit candles and held signs, including one that read "Tree of Life victims deserve better. Police say the suspected gunman, Robert Bowers, told police he wanted to "kill Jews. Bowers faces federal and state charges. Two brothers killed in the Pittsburgh synagogue shooting were an inseparable, warm-hearted pair who never missed Saturday services. Schopf says the two "looked out for one another" and were "kind, good people with a strong faith and respect for everyone around. Dan Frankel, who recalls seeing the brothers at Tree of Life whenever he went there. He calls them "very sweet, gentle, caring men. Richard Gottfried was a devoted member of the New Light Congregation, going to the synagogue every Saturday morning without fail. Stephen Cohen, the co-president of New Light, says Gottfried and another member who was also killed Saturday were the "religious heart of our congregation. The year-old Gottfried was also preparing for a new chapter in his life. The dentist, who often did charity work seeing patients who could not afford dental care normally, was preparing to retire in the next few months. Gottfried ran a dental office with his wife, Peg Durachko. In a videotaped message set to open an interfaith vigil Sunday, President Reuven Rivlin will tell participants: The people of Israel and the entire Jewish people stand with you! He says, "Violence against people because of their faith does not represent our values. Shuman says, "Both of them were very passionate about the community and Israel. Joyce Fienberg and her late husband, Stephen, were intellectual powerhouses, but those who knew them say they were the kind of people who used that intellect to help others. Joyce Fienberg was among the 11 victims of a gunman who opened fire inside the Tree of Life Synagogue in Pittsburgh Saturday. She retired in from her job as a researcher looking at learning in the classroom and in museums. She worked on several projects, including studying the practices of highly effective teachers. Leinhardt says, "Joyce was a magnificent, generous, caring, and profoundly thoughtful human being. There were other such tributes at NFL games elsewhere Sunday. Eight men and three women were murdered inside the Tree of Life Synagogue. The names of the victims, which included a pair of brothers and a married couple, were released Sunday. A law enforcement official says the man accused of killing 11 people at a Pittsburgh synagogue had a license to carry

firearms and legally owned his guns. Police say Robert Bowers killed eight men and three women in the Tree of Life Synagogue on Saturday before a tactical police team tracked him down and shot him. The victims ranged in age from 54 to 97 and included brothers and a husband and wife. Court papers say Bowers made statements about genocide and killing Jewish people. Federal prosecutors have charged Bowers with 29 criminal offenses and state authorities have also leveled charges. Bowers is scheduled to make his first court appearance Monday. Condolences and remembrances of the 11 victims of the deadly attack on a Pittsburgh synagogue Saturday are beginning to roll out on social media and in emails. They were professors and accountants, dentists and beloved doctors. Former Allegheny County Deputy District Attorney Law Claus sent an email to his former coworkers Sunday asking them to pass along his condolences to the family of Jerry Rabinowitz, a year-old personal physician. Claus says Rabinowitz was more than a physician for him and his family for the past three decades, saying, "he was truly a trusted confidant and healer. A neighbor of the man charged in the Pittsburgh synagogue massacre says the suspect kept to himself. Chris Hall said Sunday that he never heard or saw anything to indicate that year-old Robert Bowers harbored anti-Semitic views or posed a threat. Authorities say Bowers killed eight men and three women inside the Tree of Life Synagogue on Saturday during worship services before a tactical police team shot and wounded him. Bowers faces state and federal charges. Hall says nothing stood out about Bowers. He says "the most terrifying thing is just how normal he seemed. Two worshippers also remain hospitalized, one of them in critical condition. The 11 people killed in the synagogue shooting in Pittsburgh included a married couple, Bernice and Sylvan Simon, and two brothers, Cecil and David Rosenthal. David Rosenthal was the youngest at The eldest was year-old Rose Mallinger. Fellow members of the New Light Congregation say Wax was a pillar of the congregation, filling many roles there. Friend Myron Snider says Wax was a retired accountant who was unfailingly generous. Wax was in his late 80s. Authorities say gunman Robert Bowers made statements about genocide and killing Jewish people. Bowers is being treated for gunshot wounds and is due in court Monday. Authorities have released the names of the 11 people killed by a gunman during worship services in a Pittsburgh synagogue. Officials said at a news conference Sunday that the victims ranged in age from 54 to 97 and included brothers and a husband and wife. Officials previously said three women and eight men were killed. Bowers has been arrested and is being treated for gunshot wounds at a hospital. State authorities have also leveled charges. German leaders are mourning the victims of the Pittsburgh synagogue shooting and stressing the need to push back against anti-Semitism. Steinmeier wrote that "this abhorrent crime reminds us all to do what is in our power to advocate against hatred and violence, against anti-Semitism and exclusion, and to counter with determination those who incite them. A Pittsburgh police officer says in the warrant that Bowers was being treated for his injuries when he said Jews were "committing genocide to his people. The police affidavit says calls began coming in to just before 10 a. Saturday, reporting "they were being attacked. A gunman who expressed hatred of Jews exploited a vulnerability common in so many houses of worship across the country " doors that are unlocked for worship " to target a Pittsburgh synagogue. Officials say Robert Bowers was armed with a rifle and three handguns when he walked inside the Tree of Life synagogue during Sabbath services Saturday morning and opened fire, killing 11 people and wounding six in what is believed to be the deadliest attack on Jews in U. Police swarmed the building and traded gunfire with the gunman, who was shot multiple times but survived. Four police officers are among the wounded. Bowers faces 29 federal counts, including weapons offenses and hate crimes. Law enforcement officials plan to discuss the massacre at a news conference Sunday morning.

### Chapter 3 : Columbans Send Message of Mercy and Solidarity to Fiji | Columban Center for Advocacy and

*The following are excerpts from written solidarity messages to the Workers World Party 56th national conference, held Nov. in New York City. Other messages were sent by video from the FARC of Colombia and Oscar Rivera of Puerto Rico or delivered at the conference from representatives of the Cuban U.N. mission or others.*

The question “What if my church wants to send our own missionaries without the aid of a mission sending agency? Many churches come from a tradition that believes this is the best way to send and support missionaries. No question” missions is the responsibility of the Local Church. No question” when a small or large church takes complete responsibility for the sending, the financial supporting, the field mentoring, the financial oversight, the transportation and housing needs, the ministry guidance and the spiritual support of a missionary family thousands of miles from the US, there are issues to address. That fact alone is worthy of asking some serious questions. There are clearly situations in which a particular project really merits the local church sending their own team. That decision is wrought with potential land-mines. That decision can also be a tremendous means to involve the church in a great way than ever before. Cross-cultural learning requires guidance, accountability, and repeated encouragement from someone who has experienced the value of going deep into the language and culture. As an experienced missionary who can speak a second and third language fluently, I was never able to insure that the missionaries our church sent separate from a partnering agency ever learned the language. Even today they continue to use a translator and thus will never be able to communicate deep spiritual truths in the heart language of their audience. This, in my view is one of the greatest tragedies and greatest risks to the spread of the gospel through a means that indigenous communities can understand. The message must be communicate not only through intelligible words, by means of messengers that understand the subtle non-verbal communication that often carries more weight than words. Isolation, personal spiritual crisis, and marriage and family issues are nearly impossible to monitor and support without lots of opportunities for presence and touch. The warning signs were apparent to many, but there was no one on the field who was responsible for sharing those concerns with their sending church. In fact, there were two sending churches and both of us assumed the other was doing their part. We failed and the children and marriage suffered the loss. Avoidable, personal tragedy is too easy without hands-on care. Add to that the fact that the right agency might have better screened the couple and rejected them, encouraging them to stay and work on their marriage. In our case, the couple was connected to people of influence in the church, which made it nearly impossible to not send them. This subject was raised by a pastor who recently wrote a group of us and asked for policies and procedures related to local church sending absent from an agency. Thanks Gary for allowing us to make your guidelines available. If any of you have similar documents to share “please jump in and pass them on so the rest of us can benefit from your experience.
