Statute and Section “ Use this field if the statute and section from the Criminal Code are known. The statute and section should be separated by an ampersand. Also Convicted Of “ This field can be used if there is more than one conviction. Keyword “ This field can be used to search the history, details, and circumstances of a sentence appeal. This field can be valuable if the charge, statute, and section are unknown. Case Name “ The name of the parties can be entered here. Citation “ Either a neutral citation or a citation to any valid print reporter can be entered in this field. The bottom of the search screen includes a variety of options that will allow the searcher to narrow and refine the results. This includes date, age, and sex. Using these fields will make the search more specific. The currency of the Saskatchewan Court of Appeal Sentencing Digest can be checked by clicking on the currency link at the top of the screen. For example, the database is presently current to December 31st, with the exception of reserved decisions. It is important to review these commands frequently as proper use of the search commands produces better results. The ampersand is used to separate search terms that represent different concepts. The ampersand tells the database that each search result must contain both of these terms. The forward slash is used to separate search terms that are synonyms. The forward slash tells the database that each search result must contain at least one of these search terms. Keep in mind that two words with no search command between them are interpreted by the database as a phrase.
