Accounts do not agree, but the passenger list was set at between and It was due at Watches of passengers stopped at various times between About three miles east of Chatsworth there was a slight upgrade, then a downgrade and the bridge. It was very dry. When the train reached the crest of the incline, the engineers saw the burning bridge, but too late to stop. The wooden coaches piled up in a heap feet long, 50 feet wide and as high as a church steeple. A brakeman and a band director ran the three miles back to Chatsworth and sounded the alarm. The depot agent and the band master, a skilled telegrapher, began sending out messages. A Pantagraph reporter, who was also a telegrapher, received the news and his paper made a "scoop". The cars caught fire. There was no water and able-bodies passengers scooped dirt with the bare hands and threw it on the blaze. Haberkorn rang the fire bell to sound the warning, and led a group of rescuers down the track with his lantern. Relief trains came out from Gilman, Forrest and Peoria. The dead were laid out in a field and then brought by hayrack to Chatsworth. A roadway was worn along the track. Many were taken to the Masonic Hall in Piper City. Haberkorn counted 71 dead in Chatsworth. This number was later increased to The "Good Samaritans" worked all night and for several days. One couple from a Pullman car worked in their "nighties. There were no pictures in the papers, but they carried the story for days. A dog on the train was not hurt and was adopted by people in Piper City. Kind people brought food, bandages and blankets to the wreck. There was no diner on the train. Passengers nearly all carried lunch boxes and the train stopped in large towns where people could buy food. Water was carried in large urns, and Mr. Burford remarked that it was the age of the common drinking cup and he jokingly remarked there were no microbes then. There are always "ifs" in any tragedy.

List of United States water companies EPA defines a public water system PWS as one that provides water for human consumption through pipes or other constructed conveyances to at least 15 service connections or serves an average of at least 25 people for at least 60 days a year. The agency has defined three types of PWS: A PWS that supplies water to the same population year-round. A PWS that regularly supplies water to at least 25 of the same people at least six months per year, but not year-round. Some examples are schools, factories, office buildings, and hospitals which have their own water systems. A PWS that provides water in a place such as a gas station or campground where people do not remain for long periods of time. Utility cooperatives are a major provider of water services, especially in small towns and rural areas [69] [70] Private utilities. The largest private water company in the U. At least 36 states are anticipating local, regional, or statewide water shortages by , even under non-drought conditions. Hotter summers mean thirstier people and plants. In addition, more evaporation from reservoirs and irrigated farmland will lead to faster depletion of water supplies. Scientific evidence suggests that rising temperatures in the southwestern United States will reduce river flows and contribute to an increased severity, frequency, and duration of droughts. Many utilities depend on winter snowpack to store water and then gradually release it through snowmelt during spring and summer. Warmer temperatures will accelerate snowmelt, causing the bulk of the runoff to occur earlier and potentially increasing water storage needs in these areas.
