Buying ebooks requires compromises and an act of faith. The Wikipedia page on ebook formats lists a couple of dozen, but most can be discounted. Another Wikipedia page, Comparison of ebook formats , has a table to show which e-readers support which formats. However, the situation is worse than it sounds because the files can be either unprotected or protected by a DRM digital rights management wrapper. DRM can stop you from reading an ebook even if the file format is compatible with your e-reader. DRM is particularly dangerous when the file has to be authenticated by an online server because the supplier can go bust or shut down the server or cut you off.
