Physical Examination International students who study only for one semester generally need not take the physical examination. International students who study for one academic year or more must take the physical examination. The physical examination should be taken in the public hospitals one month before their departure, if the physical check-up is done at a private hospital, the student should get the certificate notarized. Physical Examination Record for Foreigner 1. The original record should stick one photo on the upper right corner with a hospital seal upon it. A copy of passport 3. Two passport-sized photos 4. The complete original reports of physical examination taken in your own country 5. Physical Examination should be taken at public hospital or facility. Certificate from private facility is not acceptable. If the period of staying is 6 months or less, students may also apply for an F visa. The physical examination is not required for this type of visa. For those who hold an F visa, their study time is shorter than the validity of the visa should be counted from the day you enter China, so they do not have to apply the residence permit. Documents Necessary for Residence Permit In order to apply for the Residence Permit, international students need to provide the following documents: A valid passport and visa copy included; 3. Registration receipt of temporary lodging from hotel or local police station copy included; 4. New students of degree program or people who apply for the first time for residence permit longer than one year should submit Certificate for Health by the local Entry-Exit Inspection and Quarantine Bureau applicants under 18 are exempt; 6. Visa or Residence Permit Application Form; 7. Other documents if necessary Insurance As requested by Ministry of Education in China, International students staying in China must possess an insurance of at least RMB, yuan worth or other currencies equal to this amount individual maximum amount of compensation for overseas medical care and accidental injury with a valid period longer than the duration of study. Students who do not have such insurance or do not have up to the above required amount cannot be enrolled. Only RMB cash is acceptable. If you purchase insurance for more than 2 years at one time, the premium for the former two years remains RMB yuan per year, and the premium from the third year is RMB yuan per year. The insurance covers hospital fees for clinic emergency treatment, clinic operation, hospitalization expenses as well as other accidental injury, etc. If You Possess Other Insurances: Please present English or Chinese proof of your overseas medical insurance originals or notarized copies Documents in other languages are not approved. The document should demonstrate that the insured individual possesses at least RMB, yuan worth individual maximum amount of compensation.

Immigrant visa applicants must complete schedule and attend their medical examinations with authorized physicians before their scheduled interview dates. If you complete your medical examination after your visa interview, processing of your immigrant visa case will be delayed until the U. Embassy or Consulate has received your medical examination results. Therefore, applicants are strongly encouraged to complete their medical exams prior to their visa interviews. Find the list of authorized physicians for the U. Embassy or Consulate where you will apply at List of U. Medical examinations performed by non-authorized physicians will not be accepted. The physical examination will at least include examination of the eyes, ears, nose and throat, extremities, heart, lungs, abdomen, lymph nodes, skin, and external genitalia. The authorized physician will either give the applicant the medical examination results to hand-carry to the visa interview or will send the results directly to the U. Preparing for the Medical Examination The first step in preparing for the medical examination is to determine which doctors in your area are authorized to perform a medical examination for U. The information shown by U. Embassy and Consulate provides the authorized physician s contact information for you to schedule your medical examination appointment, as well as instructions related to the required medical examination. Select your interview location from our List of U. This will open a document with a link to the interview checklist. You will need to follow the steps in this checklist to prepare for your interview. One of the steps will be to get a medical exam. This step will contain information on how to schedule a medical exam with an authorized physician, what to bring to the exam, and what to expect at the exam. Explain that the examination is for an immigrant visa application and give the physician the date of the interview appointment. The physician will tell you the cost of the examination and tests. Your vaccination immunization records Copies of your medical history records Your passport, identity card, laissez-passer, or travel document Attend your medical examination on the date and time you scheduled. Embassy or Consulate , nearest your residence abroad, where you will apply and be interviewed for your U.

Chapter 3 : 6+ Physical Exam Form Sample - Free Sample, Example Format Download

The Foreigner Physical Examination Form will not be submitted to UCEAP. Be sure your physician completes all sections of the Chinese health exam as instructed on the sample.

The applicants must fill in and provide the following documents genuinely and correctly. One original and one photocopy, in Chinese or in English 2. Notarized highest diploma photocopy. If applicants are university students or already employed, they should also provide documents proving they are university students or on-post employees. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with Chinese or English translations. Applicants for undergraduate studies must provide a notarized copy of high school transcripts. Applicants for other categories need to provide relevant notarized transcripts. Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with Chinese or English translations. A study or research plan in Chinese or English no less than words for undergraduates, no less than words for visiting scholars, no less than words for postgraduates. Applicants for the fine arts must submit six colored photographs of personal works two sketches, two colored paintings and two other types of works. The medical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, official stamp of the hospital or sealed photographs of the applicants are invalid. The medical examination results will be valid for 6 months. All applicants are advised to take this into consideration while determining when to take the medical examination. CSC does not accept individual applications. Selection of Institutions and Specialty Applicants may choose 3 institutions and 1 specialty as personal preferences from the 94 Chinese Scholarship institutions designated by the Ministry of Education of China. Applicants are required to fill in their preferences of institutions and specialties only from the ones listed in the Directory. The applied institutions will decide whether to admit the applicants. If the applicant has contacted and accepted by an institution listed in the Directory prior to application, please enclose the relevant admission letters as the reference to the host institution. Applications will be seen as invalid and will not be processed if the applicants are not qualified according to the recruitment regulations or the application documents are incomplete. Usually, finalized placements, specialties and duration of studies cannot be changed. Scholarship applicants accepted by Chinese institutions will be officially confirmed as Chinese Government Scholarship students with an endorsement from the Ministry of Education of China.
