Families with children lived there as well. A teenage girl, named Dorothy Dunn, drowned in a dredge pond along the creek, in August of One night, Dorothy appeared to Bertie on the second

floor, wearing a long blue dress. Bertie was very shaken by the event. On another occasion more recently, Dorothy appeared to a 7 year old girl who was visiting the Bannack State Park. The girl stated that Dorothy tried to speak to her, her mouth moving, but no sound came out. Park goers have reported seeing a girl in a blue dress looking at them from a window on the second story of the Meade Hotel. Garnet Ghost Town Credit: Nestled in the Garnet Mountains of Montana, just 50 miles from Missoula, Garnet is a cozy and secluded ghost town. Garnet was named for the semi-precious gem stone that was mined there; however, gold was what brought serious miners to the town. The town comes alive with music, laughter, and parties. Piano music is heard in the Kelly Saloon, even though there is no physical piano on the mountain any more. Disembodied footsteps have been heard. However, the sounds all disappear when an investigator touches a door nob. He was the first to hear these strange sounds. When he approached the Hotel, the sounds stopped, and there was nothing but dead silence. He walked around the building, hid in the trees, and once out of sight, the noise started up again! Once the territorial capital of the State, Virginia City is the largest ghost town in Montana. Miners flocked to the area in , when gold was discovered in Alder Gulch. The town is none-the-less haunted, however. The ghost of a hanged murdered has been seen leaning against a post, casually smoking a cigarette, shortly before disappearing. The ghost of a young girl, believed to have died during an epidemic, has been seen loitering around the costume shop. You may even hear the musical stylings of a singer at the opera house. Friendly nursing nuns have also been spotted around the Bonanza Inn, as it once was a hospital for miners. Like other gold rushes, miners rushed to the settlement in search of their fortunes and before long the hills around Bannack were filled with as many as 10, miners. With that many men during the era of the rough and tumble days of the Old West , there was bound to be violence. Henry Plummer Not long after the settlement was formed, in walked a man named Henry Plummer. Handsome, well dressed and charismatic, he gained the trust of the area miners and was soon elected sheriff of the burgeoning community. In December the miners formed the Montana Vigilantes and during the next forty-two days, the Vigilantes hanged 24 of the gang members, including Henry Plummer. Later, historians questioned the authenticity of the outlaw tale, suggesting that the whole story was only a cover for the ruthless vigilantes themselves. Today, many say that the ghost of Henry Plummer haunts this old settlement, which has long since become a ghost town. Perhaps he wants to avenge his name. When Bannack lost its county seat status to nearby Dillon in , the building sat vacant until when it was remodeled into a plush hotel. The hotel opened and closed sporadically through the years with the ebb and flow of mining activity. At one time the building acted in the capacity of a hospital. Cold spots, the apparition of a teenage girl, and sounds of crying children are often reported by those who visit this old building. The first sighting of a young girl was well over a hundred years ago. The teen is said to be that of a girl named Dorothy Dunn who drowned in a dredge pond along the creek long ago. Shortly after her death, she made her first appearance to her best friend, who was with her at the time of her death. Since then there have been multiple sightings of the teenage girl wearing a long blue dress on the second story of the old hotel. These reports often come from children, one of which reportedly stated that the ghost of Dorothy Dunn tried to talk to her. Dorothy has also been sighted standing in an upstairs window by passersby on the street below. Yet more sightings have been reported throughout the town of ghostly women dressed in their best finery. When mining played out, Bannack became a ghost town in the s. However, the Montana Department of Fish, Wildlife, and Parks saved the town from the elements and vandalism by making it a state park on August 15, Today, over sixty structures remain standing, most of which can be explored. The staff preserve, rather than restore the buildings of this old town allowing visitors an opportunity to relive the American West. About 12 years ago, my husband, mother-in-law, daughter and I went on a road trip from southwest Saskatchewan to Montana. We love visiting Montana â€” so much to see and do. After a long day of driving, I was finally able to convince my husband to make the detour to see Bannack. I am an avid fan of American ghost towns. After a leisurely stroll down the main road of Bannack â€” going into buildings that were accessible to tourists, and looking into windows of buildings that were not accessible; my daughter and I decided to sit on the front steps of the Meade Hotel while we waited for my husband and mother-in-law. I went in and closed the door firmly behind us and waited for about five minutes to see if the door was not latched properly and would open on its own, or if there were a breeze there was no breeze that hot day. It did not open by itself while I was there. A short while later, a couple opened the door and walked in. I am convinced that someone unseen welcomed my daughter and me into this fantastic-looking old hotel. I would love to go back and take pictures â€” who knows what I may find! When I visited, I found a cold spot downstairs but it was upstairs, that I got the very unpleasant feelings. This feeling continued throughout the second story, but it completely left me when I was downstairs again. I got nothing in any of the pictures I took in that building.

Both he and his unfortunate patients are said to appear and call out. The population of Bannack dwindled to nothing in about , but benefactors and now the state of Montana maintain about 60 log and timber buildings. Ranger John Phillips leads the walking tours and reenactors come out to recite and recreate some of the gruesome acts that took place in Bannack. This includes " you have been warned " an axe murder. Regardless of the weather, be sure to bring a jacket. Who really knows if something was there? The ghost tours begin at 7 p. Bannack State Park is out-of-the-way even by Montana standards, but lodging is nearby. The city of Dillon is 26 miles from the park and offers several small hotels. Jackson Hot Springs Lodge is 30 miles, and has a lodge and restaurant. Both lodges have hot spring pools. The Grasshopper Inn in Polaris, Mont. Gold rush ghosts are waiting. Jack Terrell is a writer who haunts southwest Montana.

**Chapter 5 : Bannack, Montana: The Truly Haunted Ghost Town**

*Montana Ghost Stories by Debra D. Munn. This collection of stories span the state wherever ghosts ramble and roam. The subjects are star-crossed lovers, murderers and the murdered, miners and cowboys, and Native Americans, all carefully researched and authenticated by interviews with the people who have witnessed the unknown and unexplained.*
