Sermon in a Sentence: The Bible is God's road map to show us to reach heaven and how to live on the way there. Introduction. The first necessity of a map is that it be accurate.

I have obscured the location of several of the places in this book: You may look for them if you wish. You might even find them. When traveling the road of life, the direction isn't always clear. Thumbing through the pages of Scripture pages -- God's road map- -- will guide us to his will for our lives.

You can purchase them for your car, boat, plane and even hand-held for things like hiking. You type in where it is that you want to go and it guides you, both audibly and with a map. Today I want to share with you a GPS system that will never fail. You could go down this road and turn by that big old oak tree. No, wait a minute. Did they cut that tree down last year? Anyhow, I always go a different way and take the shortcut! According to Jesus, there are even some who claim to be Christian, yet who are still lost. How tragic; especially when God has given us a clear roadmap in His Word. Today I want to share that road map with you. If you are here and you are a Christian, I want you to listen carefully as well and to take notes. As a matter of fact, I am going to encourage you mark this roadmap in your Bible so that you can help your friends and family find their way to heaven. Many have found forgiveness of sin and eternal life by following this map and you can as well today. So where do we begin? Well, with most earthly GPS systems, the first thing that has to be determined is your present location. To find that we turn to Romans 3: Many people resent being called a sinner. What will happen to such people? I can tell you one thing, they will never be saved. They will be eternally lost. Jesus told a story about two men who went up to the temple to pray. Friend, the Bible says that we all are sinners and that no sin shall ever enter into heaven. Write in the margin of your Bible, beside Romans 3: Notice that this verse has two parts. Write down Hebrews 9: Because we all have sinned. That passage tells us that God has a record of every sinful thing everyone has ever done and that each individual will have to stand before God one day and give a personal account for their sins. The Bible also tells us that after men are judged, they will be cast into a lake of fire. Now look once again at Romans 6: Write in the margin of your Bible, beside Romans 6: Would you admit with me that to lay down your life for someone else is a major demonstration of your love? What if that person was your enemy? God sent Jesus into this world to die for His enemies. Yet now he has reconciled you to himself through the death of Christ in his physical body. As a result, he has brought you into his own presence, and you are holy and blameless as you stand before him without a single fault. Yet Jesus Christ did die. He died on the cross. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. He died for your sins so that you could have eternal life. Scripture reminds us that death for a Christian is not the end. We, on this side of death, look at it with sadness. They, who are the children of God and who have passed on to the other side, look back upon it with celebration. If you have ever used a GPS, you know that along the way it instructs you where to turn. Up unto this point and time, man has been travelling in a direction that will lead to destruction. Now God guides him to make a turn that will lead to everlasting life. Notice two very important directions these two verses give us: Living a good life? Obeying the Ten Commandments? Do you believe that there are many roads to heaven and that you can choose which one seems best for you? What do you believe? In what are you placing your trust and confidence? Are you persuaded that you are a sinner in need of salvation and that Jesus had to die for your sins? Do you believe that Jesus is alive and that He can save you if you will but turn to Him and put your trust in Him? If so, the Bible says this also – 2 You must then confess this with your mouth. That means that you must make a commitment to Him as your Savior. In other words, to have faith in Jesus Christ as your Savior means that you are convinced that He is the way and the only way to heaven and based upon your conviction, you make a U-turn from the direction you have been going and commit your life to Him. When we are saved, we have a change of mind about God and our sin. It means to turn from sin and to God. Write in the margin of your Bible, Romans 6: You see, salvation in Jesus Christ is a complete transformation. We heard a voice that told us to turn from our sin and to turn towards God and we made the decision to obey that voice and turn and instead of continuing on towards sin, death and hell, we turned towards righteousness, life and heaven. Last Christmas someone gave me a GPS. I know that I am not worthy to go to heaven when I die. I turn from my sin and put my faith and trust in You as my Lord and my Savior. Critics from the left argue that America is biased in favor of Israel. Critics from the right argue that America has not allowed Israel to end the Palestinian terrorist regime on its borders. And yet Israel chases after international praise rather than protecting its own citizenry by any means necessary. Israel was built by men who sought to separate religious Judaism from the concept of a Jewish state. They were socialists and secularists. They aspired to create an Israel that would take its place among the "family of nations," as the Israeli Declaration of Independence puts it. These secular Zionists were certainly heroes, but they built Israel on shaky ground from the beginning. View Cartoon This was, and is, the problem for Israel. Israel still strives to be admitted to the "family of nations. Secular Zionism requires that Arab citizens of Israel be guaranteed equal rights. Demographic trends indicate that within decades, Israeli Arabs will compose a voting majority in Israel, allowing them to vote the Jewish state out of existence. Secular Zionism will let it happen. Yet Israel accepted United Nations Resolution only months after the war. Resolution now provides the basis for the Palestinian Trojan Horse campaign to destroy Israel. Secular Zionism forces Israel to allow the murder of its own citizens and the rape of its sovereignty. Secular Zionism dictates that Israel either forgive Palestinian terror or fight terror with one hand tied behind its back. Recommended What The Hell? Matt Vespa The essence of secular Zionism is rejection of religious Judaism. But the only way the Jewish state can survive is to become more, not less, Jewish. Israel must reject the tenets of secularism, the "family of nations" ideal. The basis of the Jewish claim to the land of Israel stems from God. For millennia, Jews have prayed for the ingathering of exiles, for a return to the Holy Land. Now, God has granted them their homeland and the weapons to defend it. Israel has the God-given obligation to defend itself against those who wish to destroy it. Secular Zionism has fulfilled its mission; it has created a homeland for the Jews. But ever since that creation, the appeasement-oriented tenets of secular Zionism have meant unending conflict.
