If a registered nurse decides to become an advanced practice registered nurse and specialize their knowledge, a master's degree will be needed. After completing this education, graduates can apply for roles as certified nurse specialists, nurse anesthetists, nurse practitioners, and nurse midwives.

CRNAs perform similar work to anesthesiologists including giving local and general anesthetics; performing epidural, spinal and nerve blocks; providing twilight sedation; and facilitating pain management for patients. Currently, hundreds of self-reporting nurse anesthetists have given their profession a perfect score in job satisfaction in a Payscale report. The AANA reports that in order for an RN to become certified in administering aesthetics, they must first complete an accredited program. The Council on Accreditation of Nurse Anesthesia Programs COA has a complete list of all programs that are acceptable for national certification organized by state. These programs can be highly competitive due to the desirability and relatively high pay of the work, so it is important to carefully examine the admission requirements prior to completing an application to ensure qualification. Finally, every two years, nurse anesthetists are required to recertify, a process which involves 40 hours of continuing education.

Pursue a Bachelor of Science in Nursing BSN or a similar degree The road to becoming a certified nurse anesthetist typically begins as an undergraduate. Although a BSN is not required for becoming a RN, students who complete these undergraduate programs may have an edge in the highly competitive application process to accredited nursing anesthetics programs. While pursuing a BSN or other qualifying degrees, it is advisable to get good grades. The accredited nurse anesthetist programs often require applicants to have maintained a GPA of 3. This criteria and the application prerequisites are covered in more detail below. Obtain a license as a registered nurse RN After completing an undergraduate program, registered nurses must become licensed. Since requirements and licensure may vary by state, it is important to check with local NCBSN Member Boards prior to registering for the exam. Get at least one year of experience as an RN in an acute care setting Prior to applying to an accredited nurse anesthesia program, candidates typically complete at least one year of work in a clinical setting such as an intensive care unit ICU , cardiac care unit CCU , or emergency room ER. Eligibility for a CCRN includes having a valid RN license, passing an exam, and completing at least 1, hours of direct critical care within the previous two years. Other prospective CRNAs choose to shadow an practicing nurse anesthetist, an experience that some programs advise prior to applying for admission. While training to be an RN, take advantage of any internship programs through local hospitals that your school might offer. Internships are a great way to get experience as a scrub nurse. Many hospitals, however, require that nurses have general nursing experience before doing a rotation in the operating rooms. Many hospitals will not hire a new RN as a scrub nurse, requiring that they have more experience. If you were able to intern as a scrub nurse during college, that might be enough to get you into a position, depending on the size of the hospital and whether or not there is an open position. Let the person doing the interviews know that you want to become a scrub nurse, as it might affect where you are placed. Some nursing positions in a hospital will give you more relevant experience for becoming a perioperative nurse than others. After you have a couple years of experience in general nursing at a hospital, begin looking for opportunities to apply for a scrub nurse position. Ask nurses who are already working in the operating rooms to let you know if there are any openings that come up. Begin checking with other nearby hospitals for open positions. Put together a resume that showcases your strengths and any experience you have. In addition, keep your resume updated so that you are ready to submit an application as soon as you hear about an opening. Although it depends on your location and the number of other nurses who want to become scrub nurses, most nurses are able to get into this position within a few years. Furthering your education, through either college courses or training seminars, can be one of the best ways to improve your chances of getting hired. This is especially important in areas where perioperative nursing positions are in high demand, and therefore harder to get. By making yourself a better prospect than many of the other nurses competing for the job, you have a better chance of getting the position.

Registered nurses often work in teams with other physicians and medical specialists in a wide range of healthcare settings including hospitals, homes, schools, community centers, or other non-medical environments. RNs often supervise other nursing professionals like licensed practical nurses LPNs , unlicensed assistive personnel and nursing students. Nursing is considered to be a very stressful job because of the direct involvement with suffering, high-pressure situations, emergencies and life or death decision making.
