Basic verb tenses include writing words with -ed and -ing endings. On this third grade reading and writing worksheet, kids change present-tense verbs to irregular.

This is not true. Most English words are spelled according to established rules. There are exceptions to each rule, but they are not as numerous as is commonly believed. These spelling rules are simple and easily learned. Even better, you will find that you already know many of them and apply them automatically as you write. If you apply the rules, you will improve your spelling ability greatly, for you will be able to spell correctly two thirds or more of all words.

Nouns Ending in a Sibilant Sound s, ss, sh, soft ch, x, z A noun ending in a sibilant sound adds es. In each case, the first form is preferred.

Nouns Ending in f or fe Some nouns ending in f add s. Some nouns ending in f or fe change the f to v and add s or es:

Nouns Ending in y A noun ending in y preceded by a vowel adds s. A noun ending in y preceded by a consonant or qu changes the y to i and adds es.

Letters, Signs, and Digits A lowercase letter, a sign, a digit, or an abbreviation with periods adds an apostrophe and s. An acronym or other abbreviation without periods, or a date, adds s without the apostrophe. For some common Latin-derived nouns ending in um, the plural may be formed either by changing the um to a or by adding s. Other Unusual Plurals A few nouns add en, change the vowel, or remain the same.

Proper Names Most proper names add s. A proper name ending in a sibilant adds es. Forming Possessives The possessive case of a singular noun is formed by adding an apostrophe and s. A plural noun that ends in s adds just an apostrophe. A plural noun that does not end in s adds an apostrophe and s. A personal pronoun adds just s.

Proper Names A singular proper name adds an apostrophe and s. Two traditional exceptions to this rule are the proper names Jesus and Moses, which add only the apostrophe. A plural proper name adds just an apostrophe.

Multiple versus Separate Ownership To indicate ownership by two or more persons, an apostrophe and s are added only to the last name. To indicate separate ownership, an apostrophe and s are added to each name.
