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However, Shams , Mohammad Reza, Ashraf, Ali Reza , and their older half-sister, Fatimeh , were not royalty by birth, as their father did not become Shah until Nevertheless, Reza Khan was always convinced that his sudden quirk of good fortune had commenced in with the birth of his son who was dubbed khoshghadam bird of good omen. This led Reza Khan to pass a law ordering all Iranians to take a surname; he chose for himself the surname Pahlavi, which is the name for Middle Persian language that itself is derived from Old Persian. She believed that dreams were messages from another world, sacrificed lambs to bring good fortune and scare away evil spirits, and clad her children with protective amulets to ward off the power of the evil eye. No matter how I would reach out in the years to come-sometimes even desperately-to find an identity and a purpose of my own, I would remain inextricably tied to my brother Mohammad Reza left Iran for Switzerland on September 7, After returning to the country, the Crown Prince was registered at the local military academy in Tehran where he remained enrolled until , graduating as a Second Lieutenant. Upon graduating, Mohammad Reza was quickly promoted to the rank of Captain, a rank which he kept until he became Shah. During college, the young prince was appointed Inspector of the Army and spent three years travelling across the country, examining both civil and military installations. They married on 15 March in the Abdeen Palace in Cairo. Their marriage was not a happy one as the Crown Prince was openly unfaithful, often being seen driving around Tehran in one of his expensive cars with one of his girlfriends. This had a major impact on Iran, which had declared neutrality in the conflict. On the second day of the invasion with the Soviet air force bombing Tehran, Mohammad Reza was shocked to see the Iranian military simply collapse, with thousands of terrified officers and men all over Tehran taking off their uniforms in order to desert and run away despite the fact they had not seen combat yet. The next day, at 4: On his way back to the palace, the streets filled with people welcoming the new Shah jubilantly, seemingly more enthusiastic than the Allies would have liked. This massive supply effort became known as the Persian Corridor. The Crown Prince confided in amazement to the British Minister that Foroughi "hardly expected any son of Reza Shah to be a civilized human being", [58] but Foroughi successfully derailed thoughts by the Allies to undertake a more drastic change in the political infrastructure of Iran. During his early days as Shah, Mohammad Reza lacked self-confidence and spent most of his time with Perron writing poetry in French. Upon arriving at the Marble Palace, Collbarn noted that "the Shah must have twenty-five custom-built cars Buicks, Cadillacs, six Rolls-Royces, a Mercedes". The relationship with his exiled father[edit] Mohammad Reza expressed concern for his exiled father who had previously complained to the British governor of Mauritius that living on the island was both a climatic and social prison. The two sent letters to one another, although delivery was often delayed, and Mohammad Reza commissioned his friend, Ernest Perron, to hand-deliver a taped message of love and respect to his father, bringing back with him a recording of his voice. I have always known that your youth and your love of the country are vast reservoirs of power on which you will draw to stand firm against the difficulties you face and that, despite all the troubles, you will emerge from this ordeal with honour. Not a moment passes without my thinking of you and yet the only thing that keeps me happy and satisfied is the thought that you are spending your time in the service of Iran. You must remain always aware of what goes on in the country. You must not succumb to advice that is self-serving and false. You must remain firm and constant. You must never be afraid of the events that come your way. You must never yield to anxiety or despair; rather, you must remain calm and so strongly rooted in your place that no power may hope to move the constancy of your will. He repeatedly clashed with his prime minister Ahmad Qavam , whom he viewed as too pro-Soviet. Mohammad Reza directed more money to the Imperial Iranian Air Force than any branch of the armed forces, and his favourite uniform was that of the Marshal of the Imperial Iranian Air Force. On 4 February , he

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attended an annual ceremony to commemorate the founding of Tehran University. Only one of the shots hit the king, grazing his cheek. Fakhr-Arai was instantly shot by nearby officers. After an investigation, it was thought that Fakhr-Arai was a member of the Tudeh Party , [81] which was subsequently banned. A deposed Mosaddegh was arrested and tried. The king intervened and commuted the sentence to three years, [99] to be followed by life in internal exile. Zahedi was installed to succeed Mosaddegh. The Prime Minister requested direct control of the army from the Majlis. Kermit Roosevelt returned to Iran on 13 July , and again on 1 August , in his first meeting with the king. A car picked him up at midnight and drove him to the palace. He lay down on the seat and covered himself with a blanket as guards waved his driver through the gates. The Shah got into the car and Roosevelt explained the mission. On 16 August , the right wing of the Army attacked. Armed with an order by the Shah, it appointed General Fazlollah Zahedi as prime minister. They failed dismally and the Shah decided to leave the country. Opposition against him grew tremendously. They roamed Tehran, raising red flags and pulling down statues of Reza Shah. This was rejected by conservative clerics like Kashani and National Front leaders like Hossein Makki , who sided with the king. On 18 August , Mosaddegh defended the government against this new attack. Tudeh partisans were clubbed and dispersed. Coup operatives made copies of the document and circulated it around Tehran to help regenerate momentum following the collapse of the original plan. The Tudeh party had no choice but to accept defeat. Gangs with clubs, knives, and rocks controlled the streets, overturning Tudeh trucks and beating up anti-Shah activists. That evening, Henderson suggested to Ardashir that Mosaddegh not be harmed. And it is easy to see now why many Iranians continue to resent this intervention by America in their internal affairs. Indeed, his system irritated the new classes, for they were barred from partaking in real power.

In 1244, the papal repudiation of the blood libel was repeated by Pope Gregory X, who also ruled that thereafter any such testimony of a Christian against a Jew could not be accepted unless it is confirmed by another Jew. Unfortunately, these proclamations from the highest sources were not effective in altering the beliefs of the Christian majority and the libels continued.

The last essay addresses a frequent issue for owners of art collections, to wit, how to pass or not the collection to heirs. Three times a year issues of this Journal will address legal questions of practical significance to collectors, dealers, scholars and the general art-minded public. Pearlstein This essay addresses legal issues commonly faced by private collectors and dealers when buying and selling antiquities. The evolving and multi-layered legal framework in which those issues must be considered can be complex, confusing and sometimes arbitrary. Introduction Buying and selling ancient art requires the prudent purchaser to research the provenience country of origin and provenance history of ownership of an object and to evaluate the available information in the context of the legal framework discussed below. In my experience, objects that have a plausible history of ownership and origin, even if not fully documented, can, generally, be safely purchased. A partially-documented history does not necessarily indicate fresh looting or illegal export. Even objects that entirely lack history are also not necessarily smuggled or looted. The demand for documented provenance is a relatively recent phenomenon and many owners simply failed to keep records of their objects, which they treated like other household possessions. Nevertheless, potential penalties for the unwitting purchaser of smuggled or stolen objects include civil forfeiture for which even bona fide purchasers are rarely compensated , and, for those who knew, or in retrospect should have known, jail. The good news is that prudence and diligent investigation will be rewarded. Set out below is a checklist of the main categories of potential legal exposure when evaluating a potential purchase: These include treaties, embargoes and import restrictions, which are all subject to different compliance regimes. Could the object be considered stolen property under U. Was the object properly exported under applicable foreign law and then properly imported under U. Each category of legal risk must be independently evaluated. They are summarized in outline form below. The prudent purchaser will go through the checklist and satisfy himself as to each category of potential liability. Also summarized below is the legal academic background and legislative history of the U. However it is less widely known that a smaller number of others, such as Japan, England and Israel, have not, and provide alternate models that allow for private ownership once the needs of national heritage are deemed satisfied. Defense policy of Japan National Security Council[edit] On December 4, , the National Security Council was established, with the aim of establishing a forum which will undertake strategic discussions under the Prime Minister on a regular basis and as necessary on various national security issues and exercising a strong political leadership. NSS sets the basic orientation of diplomatic and defense policies related to national security. Japan participates in the co-research and development of four Aegis components with the US: These are meant to guard against missile strikes. Ministry officials told that North Korea is less likely to fire ballistic missiles after it held a summit with the United States last month. But the officials also said the ministry will maintain its order to destroy any incoming missiles. They added that the ministry will be ready to quickly redeploy the PAC3 units if the situation changes. This unit will be designed to conduct amphibious operations and to recover any Japanese islands taken by an adversary. The JGSDF was to defend against ground invasion and threats to internal security, be able to deploy to any part of the nation, and protect the bases of all three services of the Self-Defense Forces. The JMSDF was to meet invasion by sea, sweep mines, patrol and survey the surrounding waters, and guard and defend coastal waters, ports, bays, and major straits. The JASDF was to render aircraft and missile interceptor capability, provide support fighter units for maritime and ground operations, supply air reconnaissance and air transport for all forces, and maintain airborne and stationary early warning units. The JSDF has not been used in police actions, nor is it likely to be assigned any internal security tasks in the future. Japan had adhered to the "pacifist" article 9 of the constitution, but would revise and might reinterpret it in order for this to take effect. The Koizumi administration, however, decided to send troops to respond to a request from the US. Even though they deployed with their weapons, because of constitutional restraints, the troops were protected by Japanese Special Forces troops and Australian units. The Japanese soldiers were there purely for humanitarian and reconstruction work, and were prohibited from opening fire on Iraqi insurgents unless they were fired on first. Japanese forces withdrew from Iraq in Japan provided logistics units for the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force Zone , which supervises the buffer zone in the Golan Heights , monitors Israeli and Syrian military activities, and assists local civilians. Their duties were peacekeeping, removal of rubble, and the reconstruction of roads and buildings. In , Japan created a law to deal with armed attacks and amended the Self-Defense Forces law. The force consists of two destroyers manned by approximately sailors , patrol helicopters, speedboats, eight officers of the Japan Coast Guard to collect criminal evidence and handle piracy suspects, a force of commandos from the elite Special Boarding Unit , and P-3 Orion patrol aircraft in the Gulf of Aden.
