Charles Davis Tillman This classic hymn was written in the form of a poem in the s by Eliza R. She was educated in rural schools and was quick to learn reading, spelling and writing. She had a natural ability to write poetry at an early age. Eliza had her poems published in the local papers, the Ohio Star and the Ravenna Courier. Eliza was converted to Mormonism at the age of 31, in Eliza was scorned and persecuted because she became a Mormon and when the persecution became unbearable in Ohio, she and her family moved to Missouri in Things were no better there, so in the family moved to Illinois. Eliza continued to publish her poetry and verses, including "O My Father," a favorite Mormon hymn. In June , Eliza was married as a plural wife to Joseph Smith. She had no children in either marriage. In , the Mormons migrated across the United States to a place they felt that God had led them, Utah. Eliza traveled with them, leaving a detailed diary of their trip. After they arrived in Utah, she gathered together some of her poems and had them published. The first volume was in The second volume was published in In , she began her church-wide service as a missionary, under the direction of Brigham Young, to all the settlements in the Western Mountains. She also reorganized the Relief Society. Eliza was viewed as second in command to the Churches Presidency. Eliza had several of her poems set to music, but this hymn is probably the most popular. Eliza died at the age of 83 in In the s, the Rev. Abbey, a Baptist pastor in Georgia, took this poem and wrote the chorus. Snow, a Mormon, and M. Tillman was born on March 20, , in Tallahassee, Fla. In , at age 12, he painted houses, sold sheet music for a company in Raleigh and peddled "Wizard Oil. Tillman was a composer of many tunes that were adapted to hymns and spirituals. He was the youngest son of a Baptist preacher, the Rev. He is buried in Westview Cemetery in Atlanta, Ga. The monument at his grave has the lyrics to this hymn inscribed on it. This hymn is found in many hymn books today in Protestant churches throughout the world. It is widely used as a funeral hymn. Refrain Blessed Savior, Thou wilt guide us, Till we reach that blissful shore; Where the angels wait to join us In Thy praise forevermore. The power of this program is the audio recording, which presents the faster songs at a variety of slower tempos to build technique. Backup behind the vocals is also covered. If you do not have access to a real banjo teacher, this video program is the next best thing allowing you to play and practice on your own schedule. Playing time is just under 9 hours of instruction giving you many many hours of enjoyable lessons on the banjo! The tablature is included at the bottom of the screen to make it easier to follow along with or without the book. The material is best suited for the 1st or 2nd year banjo student as every note, chord and finger position is explained in detail. Bluegrass Banjo Volume 2 picks up where we left off in Volume 1. The material was inspired by your many requests including a mix of songs ranging from bluegrass standards, vocal tunes, gospel, banjo instrumentals, fiddle tunes and so on. There is a little something for everyone in this project. You will find many of the techniques that you have been working on in Volume 1 in this follow up work. Bluegrass Banjo Volume 3 highlights some of the most popular vocal songs in the bluegrass repertoire. This Volume contains both slow and faster recordings in a variety of bluegrass keys to aid your accuracy. The guide instrument will be on the right side of your stereo, so it can be isolated for further study. The arrangements are realistic and designed so that you can play solos and backup behind the vocalist. There is a balanced mix of bluegrass, country, gospel, Irish, waltz and boogie. There is something here for everyone in your audience. The arrangements are for the intermediate to advance player. Bluegrass Banjo Volume 9 continues the program with more popular jamming tunes. Bluegrass Banjo Volume 10 covers a nice cross section of music from around the world. These songs were chosen by popular requests and favorites of my students. Bluegrass music has a strong connection to the old world. The Father of Bluegrass, Bill Monroe, created this unique genre from a blend of Irish, Welsh, English, Scottish and other national flavors; he then added some blue notes, a banjo, a bright Mandolin chop, twin fiddles and high vocals and bluegrass was born. I was looking for a similar inspiration when putting this project together. The arrangements are complimented with Performance Notes, Background history and Backup fills behind the vocals. Several of the arrangements include Mandolin duets. Multiple play-along audio tracks are included to help interpretation and enjoyment of the music. These audio tracks are recorded at various tempos, with and without the lead instrument; with and without the lead vocal so you can be part of "the band" picking and singing!
