The Lighthouse Family are a British duo. They consist of vocalist Tunde Baiyewu (born November 25, in London) and keyboard player Paul Tucker, (born 12 August , in Crystal Palace, London) and formed in in Newcastle upon Tyne, England after meeting at college.

Gabrielle 0 Louisa Gabrielle Bobb, known professionally as Gabrielle, is an English singer and songwriter. Bobb was born in Hackney, London. Known for her ptosis, the drooping of one eyelid, she released her debut single "Dreams" in which topped the UK Singles Chart the same year. The album of the same name also reached the top spot in the UK Albums Chart, where it stayed for three weeks. In he embarked on a solo career, releasing the album Tunde, and in released his second album, Diamond in a Rock. He is best known as a member of the British boy band Blue, forming in before splitting in and reforming in , selling over 15 million records. Webbe released two solo studio albums in and , sold over , records worldwide and had five UK Top 40 singles. They scored a number of hits in the UK charts and around the world in the s and s. Lead vocalist and founding member Marti Pellow quit the band in A fifth, unofficial member, Graeme Duffin, has been with them since It was a huge international success and spent 15 weeks atop the British charts. In December , Billboard magazine ranked them as the 83rd most successful dance artists of all-time. The lead singer of the band was the singer and songwriter Mick Hucknall, who, by the time the band was disbanded in , was the only original member left. They have had five number one albums in the UK, with their album, Stars, one of the best-selling albums in UK chart history. They received three Grammy Award nominations: The band re-formed in Simply Red have over 55 million album sales and 1 billion streams worldwide. In strict commercial terms, the band sold more records than any English act since the Beatles, though the cultural and musical importance was significantly less substantial. Eventually, the group worked its way toward Hi-NRG dance music, while also pursuing an adult contemporary ballad direction. By the middle of the decade, however, all of the members were entering their mid-twenties and became disenchanted with each other. Furthermore, the pop music tastes in Britain were shifting toward the classic guitar pop sounds of Brit-pop bands like Blur and Oasis, who were able to appeal to both the indie rock and teen pop audience. Consequently, the group called it quits in , as Oasis began to surpass Take That both in terms of sales and cultural impact. Gary Barlow born January 20, was always the central figure of Take That, serving as both lead vocalist and chief songwriter. In his late teens, he came in contact with Mark Owen born January 27, and Robbie Williams born February 13, , two other young musicians who came from middle-class backgrounds. Meanwhile, Owen had previously auditioned and failed for the football team Manchester United. The trio formed the Cutest Rush, which had a short-lived career. Barlow, Owen, and Williams agreed, and along with Jason Orange born July 10, and Howard Donald born April 28, -- two former members of a breakdancing troupe called Street Beat -- they became Take That in The single caused enough uproar for RCA Records to sign the group in the fall of , and their first single for the label, "Promises," scraped the Top 40 by the end of the year. At the end of the year, the group took home no less than seven awards at the Smash Hits Awards, and the debut continued to climb the charts, peaking at number two. Their lack of American success went unnoticed, however, when "Pray," the first single from their forthcoming second album, entered the charts at number one. In the fall, "Relight My Fire," which featured a cameo from Lulu, reached number one. Throughout the end of and , Everything Changes yielded hit singles, with the majority of the releases making their way to number one. Though it was a huge success in the U. Gary Barlow plowed ahead with Take That, and the first single from the forthcoming third album, "Back for Good," was more substantive than any of their previous singles and earned them good reviews from all quarters of the press. In particular, Robbie Williams was becoming known as the "wild" member, and was alienating himself from the rest of the group. During the summer of , it became evident that he was getting ready to break away from Take That. Williams began tagging along after Oasis, who were notorious for their drug and alcohol intake. He became the target of a number of tabloid reports about his bad behavior, and he began bragging to the weekly music press that he was working on solo material that sounded like Oasis.
