

Chapter 1 : Madeline and the Gypsies | eBay

The Madeline books are among the most honored children's books of all time. Join Madeline in another adventure when she and Pepito run off to join the carnival with a band of traveling gypsies!

The book will present windows into boarding school life, the country France, hospitals and an operation to take out an appendix! His mother attended a convent school similar to the one in the book. He was the smallest child in his class. When he was in hospital, as a young boy, he met a girl who pointed out the shape of a rabbit in the crack in the ceiling. Choose 12 words and make word families for each of them. The little girls walked in straight lines, but there were winding vines. Can you find any other opposites in the story? Make a list of them. Discuss the meanings of each of the following words. Ask students to use them in sentences. Teach your students to count to 12 in French un, deux, trois, quatre, cinq, six, sept, huit, neuf, dix, onze, douze. Introduce "hello" *bonjour* "good-bye" *au revoir* "thank you" *merci*. In pairs, they could make up conversations using this limited vocabulary and miming. As each pair presents their "conversations" to the class, encourage the audience to guess what is being said. Then make a time-line showing the school day of the students in second grade. Provide manipulatives blocks, counters, buttons and paper clips and invite the students to take 12 objects at a time and make up as many combinations for the number 12 as possible. What is another word for 12 dozen? Make up three number problems using 12 or a dozen, e. Oh, I dropped the box on the way into the house and 3 of the eggs were broken. How many were still in good shape? The little girls left the house at "half past nine. Discuss what "half past" the hour is in minutes. What is another way of expressing this time? Madeline is the main character in the story. Make a character web describing her. For a character web pattern click [here](#). Push tables and chairs, or desks, into groups of Festoon the classroom with red, white and blue streamers. Serve crackers with Brie or Camembert cheeses. If you are very ambitious, you may wish you make up a pot of French Onion Soup and serve with French baguettes. Sing "Alouette" with all the actions. Provide pictures of Madeline for coloring. Invite any students who would like to sing, play an instrument, or dance to put on a show. Many of the second grade Madeline activities from this article could be applied to these books too.

Ludwig Bemelmans named his fictional little girl after his real-life wife. This series itself has probably contributed to the more modern, simplified spelling. That explains the fetching but unusual grammatical constructions of the English. This allows the reader to focus on the characters. Accordingly, improvements in colour printing technology made it possible to produce cheaper multicoloured plates, and the Madeline books are not quite full colour. I guess the yellow and black pages were to keep printing costs down rather than adding any symbolic meaning to the story. You can probably tell from the style of the illustrations that there is nothing specifically childlike about this work. He took art classes now and then and his father was a painter but his style is self-taught. I suppose all great artists are, in the end, self taught. Bemelmans said that he felt he had no imagination and was only able to draw from real life inspiration. CHARACTERS Like other books from this era, the quasi opponents turn up in the form of gypsies , though I do like this particular story in that the gypsy mama turns out to be a goodie, as does the nun who runs the orphanage. In fact, there is no better example of carnivalesque kidlit – it literally takes place at a carnival. There is no real baddie in a carnivalesque story for young readers. Each book in the series opens with the information that Madeline is the smallest of all the girls. This is a fairytale technique, in which the smallest character is designed specifically to be the character who engenders sympathy – a proxy for the youngest child of three. Interestingly, Madeline is different from all the others because of her red hair. By the time this book was published there was no longer the view – as there had been in L. DESIRE At first Madeline just wants to get off the ferris wheel, but after the rescue by the gypsy mama and Pepito, her boy companion that it would be much more fun to follow the circus than to go back to the orphanage. The real enemy here is formal education which stunts creativity and curbs adventure. PLAN The Gypsy Mama has a rather unusual plan – when she sees in her conveniently accurate crystal ball that Miss Clavel is coming to get Madeline back, she dresses Madeline and Pepito as a scary lion so that Miss Clavel will be scared away. BATTLE Madeline and Pepito come close to death when, disguised as a realistic lion, they meet a man with a gun, who might just as well have shot them as run away in fright. Home has its advantages just as the wilderness has its advantages. There is no hierarchy anymore.
