Local anaesthetic toxicity in neonates is attributable to the following: Hepatic enzyme systems are immature for the first 3 months after birth. Local anaesthetics have a short plasma half life in neonates. The permeability of blood-brain barrier to local anaesthetics is reduced. Increased binding of local anaesthetics to plasma proteins. The larger volume of distribution of local anaesthetics prevents accumulation. Regarding the anatomy of the lumbar sacral spine: An imaginary line drawn between the two superior iliac crests the intercrystal line is above the lower level of the spinal cord at any age. The sacral hiatus is formed from the failed fusion of the 2nd to 4th posterior sacral arches. The spinal cord can extend as far down as the 4th sacral vertebra in neonates. Regarding caudal blocks in children: They reliably block dermatomes below the umbilicus in all children. The most reliable method of identifying the sacral hiatus is by locating the sacral cornua with the index finger. The incidence of dural puncture is less than 1: Adding atropine to the local anaesthetic solution containing epinephrine 1: They can be safely used in infants under 6 months. They are used to extend the height of the block. Morphine can cause late onset respiratory depression because of its low water solubility. Ketamine can prolong the mean duration of a caudal block by 12 h. The following factors are associated with an increased risk of peripheral nerve injury during anaesthesia:
