In the meantime, however, the memo had been working its way through the Trump White House. Among those who received the memo, according to two sources, was Donald Trump Jr. Many inside the White House had only seen the first page or two of the memo “ or had only read the excerpts published in the Atlantic, which first reported the existence of the memo, several sources said. This 3,word memo was written in a personal capacity, according to a source familiar with its drafting. The not-wrong part is just, well, buried a bit I guess by some of the wackier parts. The recent NSC shake-up appears to go beyond concerns about the memo.
