After the death of her husband from pancreatic cancer , Lillian Carter left for Auburn University where she worked for seven and a half years as a dormitory housemother. A year after completing her service at Auburn, Carter managed a nursing home in Blakely. Lillian later became a social activist , working for desegregation and providing medical care to African-Americans in Plains, Georgia. Lillian worked in the Godrej Colony for 21 months, during which she aided patients afflicted by leprosy. The Atlanta Regional Office of the Peace Corps has named an award in her honor for volunteers over 50 who make the biggest contribution. He was initially regarded as a dark horse candidate for the Democratic Party nomination. In , a major nursing center was dedicated in her honor in Plains by Jimmy Carter in recognition of her first years of service to the community as a nurse.
