### Chapter 2 : Faith as small as a mustard seed can move mountains. How can I have that faith? | Ancient Pa

*"I tell you the truth, if you had faith even as small as a mustard seed, you could say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it would move. Nothing would be impossible." This verse has always stuck with me because like most people I knew I could never physically move a mountain.*

He has just given the disciples two warnings about the life of faith. At those words, the disciples seem to throw up their hands in resignation, because Jesus has just laid out two scenarios that outline our responsibility for the spiritual and ethical lives of others. And, we are to forgive those immediately and repeatedly who struggle to break free from the grip of sin. Remember the story Jesus tells about the righteous man and the publican. But a little faith uproots a mulberry tree instead of a mountain. Both, however, get cast into the sea. This is not a small feat by any means, and a little faith is the key to it. It appears that Jesus is setting up an impossible goal for the disciples. Rather, Jesus means that even a little faith can move mountains – obstacles that might be in our way. Remember when you could buy necklaces and bracelets that had a single mustard seed incased in a ball of plastic that magnified its size? A little faith accomplishes big things! Because it never happens. The disciples never exhibit that kind of faith, as though faith were a superpower like super heroes possess. Why do I say that? Let me tell you how powerful faith is. Just a mustard seed amount of faith can uproot trees or mountains. That is not mountain-moving by any means, or even tree-uprooting for that matter. Because of what Jesus says after the mustard seed story. He gives an example of a servant, a story that seems to have nothing to do with faith, or with the question the disciples just asked. Probably Jesus and the disciples are outdoors, walking along. Jesus has already pointed to a mustard plant, and a mulberry tree. Now he points to a servant plowing a field, and another looking after sheep. Both were very common practices in that day, and visual examples were easy to spot. Then Jesus weaves a little story around the servants. Come, sit down and eat, and take it easy! Only after he finishes all his chores, can he then eat. God has given us all the faith we need to serve him, to live our lives as we should. And none of that takes a supernatural amount of faith, only a little faithfulness. I read somewhere that when men help around the house, they expect some kind of recognition. We have enough faith to be faithful. We have all the faith we need to be faithful. It is interesting that at this table, Jesus has done it all. In the account we will read in a few moments, Jesus has all the action verbs. Jesus takes the bread. Jesus gives it to us. Jesus does it all. He gives us his broken body, his shed blood. He does what we could not do for ourselves. He both becomes and offers the sacrifice we need. He gives us all we need, including faith, to be faithful to him.

## Chapter 3 : The Parable of the Mustard Seed and Faith

*Therefore, it is clear from the context that Jesus does not intend to assert that mustard seed-sized faith can literally move mountains. Rather, the expression Jesus uses was a common colloquialism of that day; to a Jew of Jesus' day, a mountain is a metaphor signifying a seemingly impossible task.*

Faith is the confidence that what we hope for will actually happen; it gives us assurance about things we cannot see. It takes a toll, well, sometimes, it is putting yourself in a position to be mocked or made fun of. To speak life over a person close to death takes great boldness and faith. You must be able to ignore the sneers, comments, countenance and words that go against what you believe. You must stand unshakable in Christ Jesus. So why are you afraid of mere humans, who wither like the grass and disappear?. He sought out to do the impossible. He kept his focus and led in the rebuilding of Jerusalem. Sometimes we think our situation is hopeless and there is no end, but that is not true. We can trust in God even in the most hopeless situation. God rescues us, this we can count on. Consider this trying time to be a test of your faith. He will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness is a shield and buckler. We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance. And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation. And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love. For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing. James Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. Not ashamed or embarrassed. Faith means that you are willing to look foolish before the world and those around you. He was building a huge ark- for what? It was by faith that Noah built a large boat to save his family from the flood. A friend of mine was told her mother was not going to live through the night. She spoke scriptures over her mother and told the doctors and nurses: Some laughed, some tried to comfort her with her mothers death but no one believed her words. But when you ask him, be sure that your faith is in God alone. Do not waver, for a person with divided loyalty is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind. Such people should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. Their loyalty is divided between God and the world, and they are unstable in everything they do. Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you. I wrote down scripture that defeats any lie or false thinking that may enter my mind. That may sound crazy to some, but every time I walk by the scripture I read it out loud and it changes me. I woke up so tired the other day, moping into the kitchen and boom! There was scripture in my face when I looked up. I said it out loud and I could feel my faith meter for that day increasing. In the verse below, we learn that Jesus wants to do miracles for us but unbelief gets in the way. Some were killed by plague, other times they lost their protection. Ultimately their fear and doubt caused a 2 week journey to turn

The congregation wept and cried all night long from hearing the fearful and hopeless report. They complained to Moses and doubted God. The Lord was angry and those who feared in unbelief died in the plague. Will they never believe me, even after all the miraculous signs I have done among them? I will disown them and destroy them with a plague. Then I will make you into a nation greater and mightier than they are! But my servant Caleb, because he had another spirit with him, and hath followed me fully, him will I bring into the land whereinto he went; and his seed shall possess it. Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: Faith takes patience, or waiting time in which we hope Consider the life of Joseph; he was hated and rejected by his 10 brothers. They sold him and he ended up as a slave in another land of another language. He was later forgotten in a prison cell. However, Psalm tells us that God was testing him. They hurt his feet with fetters, He was laid in irons. The king sent and released him, The ruler of the people let him go free. In Act7, we are told that God delivered Joseph from all his troubles- and that same promise is for you also. He will deliver you from all your troubles. Within my heart, I heard: Do you believe you have eternal life? I said of course I do, I believe that. I have no doubt. Do you believe Jesus died on the cross for you sins? Yes, I do, I do. Do you believe God cares for you? Yes, I do You believe everything in the bible to be true, but why does your faith toss like a wave when you are believing for me to rescue you? I have noticed that my faith can be just like the waves described in scripture. I know the enemy tries to destroy our faith in the Lord. He sends arrows of doubt, fear and unbelief into our thoughts, but God has given us the power to reject those wrong thoughts. Be strong and courageous. For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. For what does the Scripture say? And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted as righteousness, â€” Romans 4: His faithful love endures forever. Tell others he has redeemed you from your enemies. He led them straight to safety, to a city where they could live. Have a right relationship with the Lord You must love the Lord you God with all your heart, all your mind, all your soul and all your strength. You must love your neighbor as yourself. Treat your wife with understanding as you live together. Strengthen what little remains, for even what is left is almost dead.

## Chapter 4 : Can faith really move mountains?

*Truly I tell you, if you have faith like a grain of a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you." A mustard seed is only 1 to 2 millimeters which is about 1/64th of an inch!*

He often falls into the fire or into the water. How long shall I put up with you? Bring the boy here to me. Nothing will be impossible for you. The mountain represents those things that only God can overcome. The mustard seed "although tiny" is real and tangible. The point of the comparison is that faith must be more than a concept in your mind. No doubt you have heard the old example about having faith in a chair. Saying you trust the chair to support you is nothing more than words until that faith is exercised. That is how faith is proved out. As you journey through life, you can see faith do the same things that seeds do. They grow into something much bigger than what they started. Your faith "trust in God" will also grow and you will be amazed by what He does with you. Does that mean that if you trust God to change something take away the bad and bring on the good circumstances, that it will happen? No, moving the mountain is about taking away the fearful thoughts so that the circumstances are no longer something to dread. Circumstances will no longer control your life because you will trust God to do what is good for you "and for those around you. It would be better for him to be thrown into the sea with a millstone tied around his neck than for him to cause one of these little ones to sin. Would he thank the servant because he did what he was told to do? As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. Where are the other nine? Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner? Throughout the Bible the amount of power, or the position in society, that people held is represented by trees. And it provides shelter and food for those it is over. Being able to forgive that person requires faith "faith that God is using that trouble to transform you into the likeness of His Son "faith that God is concerned with you and your future "faith that He will carry you through your current situation and bring you into maturity. Just like the mustard seed that starts tiny and becomes a great tree "you will become a person of influence for others. And as a tree you will produce fruit "fruit of the Spirit. Jesus let them think about this for a while. Then on their walk to their next lesson, He drove the point home by relating His personal experiences. After He healed ten lepers, only one of them gave thanks. Does He hold their unforgiving attitudes against them? Through this story, He lets us see His heart so that we can understand how we humans offend Him and yet He continues to love and accept us. Jesus trusted His Father to work out all things for good. Likewise, we too can see the results of our faith when we turn our weaknesses over to God "wanting with all our hearts to forgive without ever again remembering the offense. Feeling the release from anger toward the offending person is like seeing your mustard seed begin to grow. God took the Israelites through many journeys. Whenever there were difficult encounters, they saw Him at work. He took them across the sea and the river; He gave them food and drink; He drove out their enemies before them. They piled up stones as reminders of what He had done for them at these junctions. Remembering His faithfulness is like looking at the mustard seed to remind yourself that He is real "that He gives life its purpose. Our heavenly Father provided our Sacrifice for all times "His Son" as redemption for us all!

### Chapter 5 : What does it mean to have mustard seed faith?

*In Matthew, mustard seed faith is tied to expelling a demon, and Jesus says those who have such faith can move mountains (Matt. ). In Luke, those with mustard seed faith will be able to forgive those who sin against them since such faith can pluck up mulberry trees and cast them into the sea (Luke ). All kinds of questions enter our minds.*

Can faith really move mountains? In order to correctly interpret a passage such as Matthew Jesus then chastises them for their lack of faith and then casts the demon out of the boy. Their faith, He says, is small and weak. God condescendedâ€”He lowered Himselfâ€”to speak to us in ways in which we would understand. Consider a father trying to communicate with his young child. The father has to condescend in order to be understood by the limited intellect and understanding of the child. This is analogous though not identical to the way in which God speaks to us. The Bible employs many forms, or genres, of literature. There is historical narrative, poetry, prophecy, apocalyptic writing, and epistolary literature to name a few. Among these various literary genres, several literary techniques are usedâ€”metaphor, simile, imagery, parable, allusion, irony, personification, paradox, and hyperbole. As readers of the Bible, we must recognize when these techniques are being used so we can properly interpret the meaning. For example, in John If we are too literal, we might start looking for a doorknob hidden somewhere on His body. However, if we understand this to be a metaphor, then we can begin to understand His meaning Jesus is the way of access to eternal life, much like a door is the way of access into a room. Another thing to consider in biblical interpretation is the context of the passage. More often than not, when we take a single verse out of its native context, we end up misinterpreting the verse. In the context of Matthew 17, Jesus rebukes the disciples for their weak faith and says that even if they had mustard seed-sized faith, they could command the mountain to move. Jesus tells His disciples that, if their faith was stronger, they could have commanded the demon to leave the boy, and it would be so. This was clearly the case in Matthew 10 when Jesus sent them out to cure diseases, cast out demons, and spread the gospel. Therefore, it is clear from the context that Jesus does not intend to assert that mustard seed-sized faith can literally move mountains. Faith that can move mountains is not meant to imply a faith that can literally move literal mountains. The point Jesus was making is that even a little bit of faithâ€”faith the size of a tiny mustard seedâ€”can overcome mountainous obstacles in our lives.

## Chapter 6 : Matthew - He replied, "Because you have so - Bible Gateway

*Matthew New International Version (NIV). 20 He replied, "Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move.*

That means He is much bigger than any mountain. Did you know that when we talk about mountains in our lives it can also mean something different. Just like climbing a mountain, they can seem really difficult and we just want them to go away. But with Jesus, we can overcome any mountain " any problem " in our lives. God gives us His Holy Spirit to help us overcome anything. But in all these things we have full victory through God who showed his love for us. God is with us in every problem we have. No matter what happens to us we will always have the love of Jesus and we can overcome anything in His power. When you are close up to a mountain it looks huge" but if you have ever flown above one in an airplane you will know they can look pretty small too. All we need is a little faith. Choose a bible verse about faith from the list below and ask the children to pray about who they should give their bible verse to. Encourage them to write a little note with the bible verse that explains why they have given this verse to the person. Some children will need help with this and will need some direction. Make sure you talk with them before they write the note. Why did you choose this verse? Who do you think needs to hear this verse today? Why do they need to hear this verse? What might you say to encourage that person? Tape a mustard seed to some card and put two holes in it. Thread it with a piece of elastic. Then add beads to the elastic before tying. Alternatively, you could also use the instructions here. Plant a seed and decorate the outside of the cup. Choose a seed that will grow during the season that you are planting. Use the instructions for the seed to decide on how you will plant it and in what container. Get messy with Mustard seed tree hand painting. Simply use brown paint on one hand and green paint on another. Use the brown paint to create the trunk and the green paint to create the leaves. Make your own Mustard seed bookmarks with smaller kids. Want a food craft? Why not try creating your own mustard seed cupcakes or cookies with small chocolate sprinkles. Do this for every child. When we have a mountain " a problem " that we need to see moved in our lives we can ask God to move it for us. Sometimes we may need to keep asking every day. Sometimes the answer will be yes, sometimes no and at other times God will ask us to wait. He always knows the answer that is for our best. Yet when we keep praying it lets God know that we really care about the problem and we need His help to get through it. Do you have a problem that you want to see

Jesus says in Luke If you had faith as a mustard seed you could tell a mountain to move and it would do it. But, most Christians are not moving any mountains or uprooting any trees. Most Christians interpret the Luke So what is a mustard seed like? Well, not only is it smaller than all the other seeds in a garden, but when it is planted, it grows up and becomes a tree that is larger than all the other garden plants; producing large branches for birds to nest in. Jesus is saying that your faith should be like a mustard seed. That first, you have to sow it. You have to plant or sow your faith. Then, when you do, it will grow and grow and produce works in you that you never thought possible. Yes, there is much more to the mustard seed than just its size. So much so that Jesus compared the Kingdom of Heaven to a mustard seed in the book of Mark 4: Insinuating that the Kingdom of Heaven would begin with a small group of men, the disciples of Jesus Christ, but will blossom and be an influence in the life of many people, spreading out its branches as a refuge to those willing to accept it. Faith is no good unless it is sown; unless it is planted. Unfortunately, there are many who think they are pleasing God, but are not. Simply because they will not sow their faith. Yes, each man may be allotted a measure of faith, but you have to sow it. Just plant the faith you have. It is obvious that many Christians are not sowing their faith. If so, there would not be so many broken, hurt, and down-trodden Christians. Faith is the most important piece of armor that we have to fight against Satan? The King James version says that with the shield of faith you can ward off all, not some, ALL the fiery darts of the wicked. That means that if Satan throws cancer your way, guess what? You hold up your shield of faith. If Satan throws a wayward husband, wife, or child your way, guess what? If you need to pay off the cost of your church building and the people in your congregation are not giving generously, then guess what? Hold up your shield of faith. Because it can and will extinguish every fiery dart of the enemy. Yes, faith is a very powerful tool, yet so few really use it. This is how powerful Hebrews It was that powerful tool called faith that caused many to be healed. As Jesus healed, He said to those who were healed, your faith has made you well, your faith has saved you. If we are going to be saved or if we are going to be well, it will be because of our faith. I say to you, it is faith in the Lord Jesus Christ that people will need in these last days. Certain persons have crept in unnoticed into our churches, those who were long beforehand marked out for condemnation, ungodly persons who turn the grace of our God into lustful desires and deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ. Many of them have come preaching false doctrine, exploiting you for their own monetary gain. But, these are just precursors of what is to come. For Revelation, chapter 13 says that a beast will come who will deceive many because of the great signs and wonders that he does and he will cause all who dwell in the earth to worship the Antichrist, the one who will proclaim that he is God.
