**How To Prepare Furniture For Moving** The last thing to do before actually packing your furniture for shipping is to prepare the pieces in order to make the relocation process as safe, easy, and simple as possible. Empty and clean your furniture Leaving your books in the bookcase or your plates and glasses in the kitchen cabinets and expecting the movers to pack them and load them onto the moving truck as they are is definitely quite unrealistic, to say the least. You need to remove all the items from your furniture in order to make the large pieces a bit lighter and safer to lift and carry. Pack the contents of your furniture separately, according to their type and handling requirements, to provide adequate protection for each of your smaller possessions. The only exception – you may leave small clothing items or office supplies in their respective drawers, especially if you are moving short distance, as they are not particularly prone to damage and will not add much to the weight of the dressers or desks. It is also a good idea to clean your empty furniture pieces before packing them. You will probably want to have everything thoroughly cleaned when you reach your final destination but you may not have the time and the energy to address the matter immediately upon arrival. Disassemble furniture for moving Your comfortable bed will be the last one to be disassembled and packed after having wished you good night one last time in your old home. Dismantle your furniture as much as possible: Removing any detachable parts will make the furniture easier to move and will help prevent damage caused by hitting or brushing your pieces against walls and door frames. It will also make it easier to arrange your large and awkwardly-shaped items in the moving truck. However, when disassembling your furniture , stick to the following useful tips: To correctly dismantle a specific furniture piece, refer to its manual if you keep it or find instructions online; Put screws and other small hardware from each piece of furniture into a separate sealable plastic bag. This will help you reassemble the item quickly and correctly when you get into your new home. Any larger disassembled parts should then be carefully wrapped and stored in boxes. It is a good idea to dismantle your furniture except the bed, of course the day before moving day – you will save some valuable time. **Packing Tips For Moving Furniture** When packing furniture for moving or storage, your primary concern should be to ensure their safety. Cardboard boxes may not be of much use as most furniture pieces are too large to get into a box. **How To Pack Furniture For Shipping** Designate a clean and flat place to pack your furniture – you need a large space where no other items will get in your way and cause eventual damage. If any of your items can make it to your new place in excellent condition, these chairs will! Consider paper or cloth padding for additional protection whenever necessary around fragile small elements, over intricate decorations, in remaining small hollow spaces, etc. Use plenty of bubble wrap around furniture legs that cannot be removed and secure cabinet doors and drawers with cardboard pieces. They provide maximum protection from rips, stains, and moisture. Although the above tips for packing furniture describe the best way to protect furniture when moving, there a few more specifics you should be aware of: Apply wax on fine wooden surfaces to protect them against scratches; Have in mind that tightly sealed shrink wrap can cause mold to form. Leave some air holes in strategic places to allow the furniture to breathe and to prevent moisture and mold from building up inside; Do not use plastic wrap directly on wooden or leather furniture. Otherwise, moisture may be trapped underneath the plastic wrap and cause the wood or leather to warp or mold. Besides, when the temperatures are high, shrink wrap can adhere to the leather and damage it. Always wrap leather and wooden furniture in paper padding first and then use plastic wrap to secure the wrapping to the furniture; You can use plastic wrap directly on upholstered furniture to keep dust and dirt off. Now that you know how to protect furniture during a move, you need to turn your attention to the actual process of taking your pieces to the moving truck. In the best case scenario you will have hired professional movers to complete the strenuous task of hauling your large furniture and loading it on the moving truck. Clear obstacles out of the way – remove small items, slippery leaves, and anything that might cause the movers to slip, trip or fall. Consider

removing the doors from their hinges to provide some extra inches of free space and to avoid damage to the doors; Prevent property damage – cover the floors with plywood sheets and carpet film protectors this way you will not only prevent scratching, scuffing or denting the floors, but will also keep dirt away from your carpets. You can use scrap cardboard pieces, towels and newspapers instead the professional protective materials, but make sure to hold them securely in place and avoid slippery covers. Using corner guards is a must and you may also consider covering the walls and installing foam paddings on the door frames. Never drag furniture directly along the floor! If you are up to the relocation challenge and you are moving house without professional assistance, there is one more crucial factor to take into account – your own safety. To avoid injuries on moving day , you need to be familiar with proper lifting and moving techniques and to wear personal protection gear. [How To Pack Furniture In A Moving Truck](#) However efficiently you cope with the task, disassembling and wrapping furniture for moving will not ensure the safety of your pieces unless they have been properly secured in the moving truck. So, when loading the truck, keep the following tips in mind: Let the furniture-matching fun begin! Line the floor of the moving truck with moving blankets to protect the bottoms of your pieces and to add some extra protection against vibrations or if some of you items accidentally topple on the floor; It is generally recommended to create a wall of boxes across the back end of the truck first. Place them directly against the boxes for added cushioning and use blankets or corrugated cardboard between pieces for extra protection; Use the hooks or paneling on the inside of the truck to secure your furniture with strong ropes; Move in your mattresses next – be sure to place them upright and put flat fragile items such as paintings or mirrors between them; Arrange your oddly-shaped furniture in the remaining space. Remember that upholstered pieces need additional care, so add a layer of blankets around them for extra safety and carefully choose which items to place around them; You can put more boxes or other items on top of your furniture but choose light ones and be sure to prevent slippage; Make sure the truck is properly balanced – objects of similar weight should be placed on opposite sides of the truck; Be very careful when unloading the truck and taking your furniture into your new home as well. If you have hired professional movers to help you with your relocation, they will know all the above tips, of course, as well as many other useful specifics. Your furniture will be in good hands! Especially if you are moving antique furniture or extremely delicate pieces, such as a piano , you are strongly recommended to take advantage of the competent services movers offer. Anyway, consider proper insurance for your valuable furniture items and keep all receipts, contracts, etc. If your furniture pieces will be placed in storage for a certain period of time, you need to have some extra specifics into account when packing them.
