*Percy Jackson & the Olympians, often shortened to Percy Jackson, is a pentalogy of fantasy adventure novels written by American author Rick Riordan, and the first book series in the Camp Half-Blood Chronicles.*

During the remaining three books in the third-person his character develops significantly. He develops an irrational fear of drowning; is humbled by weakening sword-fighting skills; and expresses a new tendency to make ambiguous moral choices in defense of his friends and family. Though Percy is related to virtually every character and creature in Greek mythology through his father Poseidon, Tyson is one of the only beings whom he acknowledges as family. Percy first met Tyson at a school called Meriwether Prep, and did not learn of their relationship until much later. Percy is also distantly related to horses, pegasi, some other monsters, and numerous gods and demigods through his father. Significant examples of this would be that he is technically a grandson of Kronos, nephew to Hades, Zeus, and numerous other Olympians as well as the half-nephew of Chiron. His next-oldest friend is Annabeth Chase, whom he meets when she helps nurse him back to health after his first fight with the Minotaur. The two accompany him on his first, and most of his subsequent, quests. Frank Zhang is also a descendant of Periclymenus, descendant of Poseidon, and so distantly related to Percy. As the final battle with the Titans approaches after The Battle of the Labyrinth, Percy spends time with his mortal friend Rachel Dare. Their relationship causes conflict between Percy and Annabeth Chase. Towards the end of The Last Olympian Rachel realizes that her attraction is not to Percy, but to his mythological world, because of her destiny as the next Oracle of Delphi. Blackjack is first referred to as a "mare" in The Sea of Monsters, though he is called a stallion in all later books. Blackjack always calls Percy "boss" and is quite fond of sugar cubes and doughnuts. Blackjack has two friends named Porkpie and Guido, both white pegasi, who sometimes accompany him. All three are intelligent beings capable of interacting with other demigods independent of their horse-to-human translator, Percy. She is a hellhound that he receives from Daedalus whom Percy meets as a sword master named Quintus before the inventor dies. Percy often refers to her as "his dog". Percy sometimes uses Mrs. His brother Tyson and dead friend Charles Beckendorf are Mrs. It later saves the life of Tyson and returns to help the two brothers on several occasions. Percy has also traveled with a small calico kitten called Small Bob by Bob the Titan. He is fond of Bob and protective of the traveling group, leading Bob to call him "a good monster". It is unclear if he lives or dies, but he is not mentioned again. His mother notes that Percy looked just like his father, and his friend Hazel says that he has the looks of a Roman god. After being trained at Camp Half-Blood, he has developed a Greek fighting style described as unpredictable by New Romans and is an expert swordsman. After bathing in the River Styx, Percy was given the curse of Achilles, making him invulnerable except for the small of his back. He loses this power when it is washed away in the Little Tiber surrounding New Rome, as part of his acceptance there. Percy is gifted with several semi-divine abilities: Water also provides Percy with a measure of protection from injury and fire. Riptide can change shape; when it is not a sword, it appears as a ballpoint pen engraved with its name. Since it is made of celestial bronze it will harm gods, demigods, and monsters, but simply passes through mortals. Percy has also used magic javelins made by his brother

Tyson, magically camouflaging armor made by Charles Beckendorf , and the wand of Carter Kane. Percy has several magical items obtained from battles against monsters. The first of these is the horn of the Minotaur , which he obtains after killing the beast on Half-Blood Hill. Another is the head of Medusa , which he cuts off after killing the gorgon. He gives the head away several times, finally leaving it with his mother who "disposes of it".

After The Last Olympian, the next time Percy is seen is in The Son of Neptune, the second book in the sequel series The Heroes of Olympus.*

During a Capture the Flag game, Ares campers attack him, all wanting revenge for what he had done to Clarisse. Clarisse stabs him with her electric spear but he steps in the creek and gains the upper hand. Just as he defeats all of the campers, Luke crosses the line with the enemy flag and wins the game. She asks Percy to step out of the water and Percy soon feels weakened. Annabeth jumps to the conclusion of who his father may be. Suddenly, a hellhound attacks Percy, wounding the demigod. The hellhound is killed and Annabeth shows Chiron what happens when Percy is in the water. Percy is claimed as a son of Poseidon through a hologram of green light in the form of a trident. Percy being claimed in the graphic novel. This is a surprise to many as it is revealed that the three elder gods – Zeus, Poseidon, and Hades – have taken an oath to never have demigod children again. You shall find what was stolen, and see it safely returned. You shall be betrayed by the one who calls you friend. And you shall fail to save what matters most in the end. Percy has ten days before the summer solstice to find the symbol of power of the king of gods, and he is given magic shoes as a "gift" from Luke before leaving. However, Chiron tells him that it is a bad idea to use the shoes since Zeus might blast him out of the sky, so he gives them to Grover. Chiron hands over a pen to Percy, informing him that it is a gift from his father. When uncapped, a sword, called Riptide or Anaklusmos, appears. When they get on the bus, three old ladies get on with them. Percy recognizes one of them as Mrs. However, she tries to turn them to stone instead of using them as models because she is Medusa. Percy cuts off her head, and they leave. They buy train tickets with that money and get off at the Gateway Arch. When Percy is alone on the top, Echidna reveals herself, along with her pet, the Chimera. Percy battles the Chimera and is poisoned during the fight. Knowing that the water beneath him will purge the poison from his system, Percy jumps into the Mississippi River to escape the Chimera and is on the news – in a bad way. After Percy lands in the Mississippi River he discovers some of his powers which include breathing and staying dry underwater. A Nereid then appears and tells him to go to the ocean before he goes into the Underworld. Percy finds his friends, and they get back on the train and are taken to Denver. They get off, and go into a diner. They go to Waterland and find out the ride was set up with a trap by Hephaestus. Immediately, without even having to pay for anything, Percy, Annabeth, and Grover are given a room. After they enjoy the perks of staying in such a luxurious suite, they decide to go down to the arcade. After a while of playing, Percy finds a boy, Darrin , who thinks the year is Percy asks a few more people what the year is, to which they answer and Percy finds Annabeth and Grover and they immediately leave the hotel. They are relieved to find out from a newspaper that it is still the same year. However, 5 days have already passed, leaving only one day to retrieve the lightning bolt. Percy realizes that Ares has tricked him when he discovers the Master Bolt is in his backpack. He and his friends then use the pearls to flee from the Underworld without his mother as he was forced to leave her, thus fulfilling the line in the prophecy that states, "You shall fail to save what matters most in the end". They reach the shore, meet Ares, and confront

him. Percy then challenges him to a fight. He uses Riptide to battle Ares. Percy eventually stabs him in the heel and Ares starts to bleed ichor. He is about to kill Percy when an evil force in the form of a dark aura convinces him to not strike Percy. Ares then leaves, giving Percy the Helm of Darkness. Percy tosses it to the Furies, and they take it back to Hades. The End Returning the bolt in the graphic novel. Percy flies back to New York City to give the lightning bolt to Zeus, despite the dangers of flying. Due to the rivalry between Zeus and Poseidon He proceeds to the Empire State Building and reaches the top, where Olympus is currently located.
