Geography[edit] Oyo State covers approximately an area of 28, square kilometers and is ranked 14th by size. The landscape consists of old hard rocks and dome shaped hills, which rise gently from about meters in the southern part and reaching a height of about 1, metre above sea level in the northern part. In this location there was earlier habitat for the endangered African wild dog , *Lycaon pictus*; [6] however, this canid is thought to have been locally extirpated at the present.
