Coverage of evidence-based practice starts in Chapter 1, and includes references throughout the text that link to evidence-based guidelines, recommendations, and practices. Teach effective communication skills, and how to avoid common mistakes NEW: Foster interviewing and communication skills. A new Chapter 7, Interviewing and Communication Techniques, helps the student to understand and develop their interviewing and communication skills in order to develop healthy nurse-patient relationships and collect data appropriately. Help students communicate more effectively. Patient Interaction features present brief clinical scenarios and interactions between client and nurse to present examples of both positive and negative communication techniques. These are common issues that present challenges to nurses, and the Analysis at the end of the interaction offers the student goals that the nurse needs to obtain with this specific patient. Guide client interviews with expert interviewing techniques. In Gathering the Data sections, students learn how to gather subjective data while conducting a patient interview. Get new nursing students up and running quickly. Focused Interview Questions share expert advice that professionals typically learn only through years of practice. Give practical tips to follow-up. Follow-up questions help the student gather more data from the interview, while Rationales and supporting Evidence help the student understand why the nurse needs to ask these questions. Additional Evidence has been provided to support the Rationales for Focused Interview Questions, and references have been moved to the end of each chapter to provide easier access to further resources. Highlight the issues associated with assessment of diverse patients NEW: Walk students through the recommended assessment procedure for vulnerable populations. A new Chapter 6, Assessment of Vulnerable Populations, highlights assessments in groups which are not well integrated into the healthcare system because of ethnic, cultural, economic, geographic, or health characteristics. Sensitize students to the issues associated with assessment. Special Considerations boxes highlight the differences that nurses should consider while performing assessments. Provide students with a more comprehensive view into assessing common populations. Content related to assessment of pediatric and

older adult populations is now integrated throughout the body systems. Enhance the learning process Ensure that students recognize crucial health issues. Reinforce the key steps of performing physical exams. Helpful Hints provide suggestions and reminders about conducting the physical assessment. Familiarize students with the equipment used in examinations. Equipment boxes identify the modern equipment nurses need to conduct an examination. Key Terms at the beginning of each chapter identify the terms student will encounter in conducting each assessment, and the pages where these terms are defined.
