Hall, Michael Rosbash and Michael W. Young for their discoveries of molecular mechanisms controlling the circadian rhythm Life on Earth is adapted to the rotation of our planet. For many years we have known that living organisms, including humans, have an internal, biological clock that helps them anticipate and adapt to the regular rhythm of the day. But how does this clock actually work? Young were able to peek inside our biological clock and elucidate its inner workings. They showed that this gene encodes a protein that accumulates in the cell during the night, and is then degraded during the day. Subsequently, they identified additional protein components of this machinery, exposing the mechanism governing the self-sustaining clockwork inside the cell. We now recognize that biological clocks function by the same principles in cells of other multicellular organisms, including humans. With exquisite precision, our inner clock adapts our physiology to the dramatically different phases of the day. The clock regulates critical functions such as behavior, hormone levels, sleep, body temperature and metabolism. There are also indications that chronic misalignment between our lifestyle and the rhythm dictated by our inner timekeeper is associated with increased risk for various diseases. Our inner clock Most living organisms anticipate and adapt to daily changes in the environment. He wondered what would happen if the plant was placed in constant darkness. He found that independent of daily sunlight the leaves continued to follow their normal daily oscillation Figure 1. Plants seemed to have their own biological clock. Other researchers found that not only plants, but also animals and humans, have a biological clock that helps to prepare our physiology for the fluctuations of the day. But just how our internal circadian biological clock worked remained a mystery. An internal biological clock. The leaves of the mimosa plant open towards the sun during day but close at dusk upper part. They demonstrated that mutations in an unknown gene disrupted the circadian clock of flies. They named this gene period. But how could this gene influence the circadian rhythm? Jeffrey Hall and Michael Rosbash then went on to discover that PER, the protein encoded by period, accumulated during the night and was degraded during the day. Thus, PER protein levels oscillate over a hour cycle, in synchrony with the circadian rhythm. A self-regulating clockwork mechanism The next key goal was to understand how such circadian oscillations could be generated and sustained. They reasoned that by an inhibitory feedback loop, PER protein could prevent its own synthesis and thereby regulate its own level in a continuous, cyclic rhythm Figure 2A. A simplified illustration of the feedback regulation of the period gene. The figure shows the sequence of events during a 24h oscillation. When the period gene is active, period mRNA is made. This gives rise to the inhibitory feedback mechanism that underlies a circadian rhythm. The model was tantalizing, but a few pieces of the puzzle were missing. To block the activity of the period gene, PER protein, which is produced in the cytoplasm, would have to reach the cell nucleus, where the genetic material is located. Jeffrey Hall and Michael Rosbash had shown that PER protein builds up in the nucleus during night, but how did it get there? In Michael Young discovered a second clock gene, timeless, encoding the TIM protein that was required for a normal circadian rhythm. In elegant work, he showed that when TIM bound to PER, the two proteins were able to enter the cell nucleus where they blocked period gene activity to close the inhibitory feedback loop Figure 2B. A simplified illustration of the molecular components of the circadian clock. Such a regulatory feedback mechanism explained how this oscillation of cellular protein levels emerged, but questions lingered. What controlled the frequency of the oscillations? This provided insight into how an oscillation is adjusted to more closely match a hour cycle. The paradigm-shifting discoveries by the laureates established key mechanistic principles for the biological clock. During the following years other molecular components of the clockwork mechanism were elucidated, explaining its stability and function. Keeping time on our human physiology The biological clock is involved in many aspects of our complex physiology. We now know that all multicellular organisms, including humans, utilize a similar mechanism to control circadian rhythms. A large proportion of our genes are regulated by the biological clock and, consequently, a carefully calibrated

circadian rhythm adapts our physiology to the different phases of the day Figure 3. Since the seminal discoveries by the three laureates, circadian biology has developed into a vast and highly dynamic research field, with implications for our health and wellbeing. The circadian clock anticipates and adapts our physiology to the different phases of the day. Our biological clock helps to regulate sleep patterns, feeding behavior, hormone release, blood pressure, and body temperature. Key publications Zehring, W. Mandela died "peacefully" Thursday night at 95 at his home in Johannesburg, surrounded by family, according to South African President Jacob Zuma. Our people have lost a father. Although we knew that this day would come, nothing can diminish our sense of a profound and enduring loss. Zuma said the man considered by many as the father of his nation would be accorded a full state funeral. In Washington, President Obama called him one of the "most influential, courageous and profoundly good" people to ever have lived. Outside the Soweto home where he once lived, some residents sang and danced while others gathered outside his Johannesburg home, where the mood also was lively. A makeshift shrine appeared composed candles, a national flag and bouquets of flowers, along with a picture of him inscribed "Rest in peace, Madiba" -- his clan name.. Mandela, who once said, "the struggle is my life," was a beloved hero of both South Africa and the world itself. His face was instantly recognizable in virtually any country, his story famous enough that he was portrayed in movies at least four times - by Morgan Freeman "Invictus" , Sidney Poitier "Mandela and de Klerk" , Danny Glover "Mandela" and Dennis Haysbert "Goodbye Bafana". Stamps were issued with his likeness, songs written about him, statues erected in his honor everywhere from Johannesburg to London and more than 50 universities around the world awarded him degrees. Even a species of spiders was named in his honor. Mandela, who had been in increasingly frail health in recent years, retired from public life in He is survived by his third wife, Graca Machel, three daughters three other children died and multiple grandchildren and great-grandchildren. In one of his last public appearances, televised in May , Mandela sat in an armchair with a blanket pulled over his lap at his rural home in Qunu and received a symbolic flame to mark the centenary of the African National Congress. Ironically, the leader hailed as a symbol of peace at one point was on a U. He was finally taken off the list in Mandela, although initially committed to non-violence, had, in fact, once been involved with the militant wing of the ANC, which was founded in association with the South African Communist Party and carried out a campaign of violence against government targets. The man who died an anti-apartheid hero, world statesman and symbol of the strength of the human spirit was born Rolihlahla Mandela in a village near Umtata in the Transkei on July 18, Rolihlahla literally means "pulling the branch of a tree" but more colloquially, "troublemaker. He received the English name Nelson from a primary school teacher at his mission school. He attended the University College of Fort Hare, a prestigious residential college for blacks in South Africa, where he was expelled over a student boycott, and then ran away from home to Johannesburg to avoid an arranged marriage. After 20 years of leading a non-violent campaign against the South African government, his philosophy switched to armed struggle. In he was sentenced to life imprisonment for plotting to overthrow the government by violence. For 18 of his 27 years in prison, he was inmate on Robben Island, a notorious maximum security facility off Cape Town, where he became a worldwide symbol of resistance to racial oppression. In , he was moved to Pollsmoor Prison, on the nearby mainland, where he spent much of his time in solitary confinement. In , President P. Botha offered to release him if he would renounce armed struggle but he refused, saying "only free men can negotiate. Prisoners cannot enter into contracts. In he and President Frederik Willem De Klerk were jointly awarded the Nobel Peace Prize and in , at the age of 75, he was inaugurated as the first black president of South Africa. Mandela served as president until , when he retired and became an advocate for a number of human rights organizations and also a spokesman for the fight against AIDS. In he was treated for prostate cancer. His philosophy of learning to love instead of hate made him one of the moral leaders of his era. His first wife was Evelyn Ntoko Mase, from , and they had four children " one son died in a car crash, one son of AIDS and one daughter as an infant. His second wife was Winnie Madikizela-Mandela and they had two daughters before divorcing. On his 80th birthday in he wed Graca Machel, widow of Samora Machel, the former Mozambican president. But his nation was his beloved offspring as well.

During her Communist phase "56 she wrote radically about social issues, a theme to which she returned in *The Good Terrorist* . This was followed by a psychological phase from to , including the *Golden Notebook* and the "Children of Violence" quartet. Third came the Sufi phase, explored in the *Canopus in Argos* sequence of science fiction or as she preferred to put it "space fiction" novels and novellas. For example, in *The New York Times* in John Leonard wrote in reference to *The Making of the Representative for Planet 8* that "[o]ne of the many sins for which the 20th century will be held accountable is that it has discouraged Mrs. She now propagandises on behalf of our insignificance in the cosmic razzmatazz," [46] to which Lessing replied: I also admire the classic sort of science fiction, like *Blood Music* , by Greg Bear. Here she made a speech in which she described her dystopian novel *Memoirs of a Survivor* as "an attempt at an autobiography. Using Sufi concepts, to which Lessing had been introduced in the mids by her "good friend and teacher" Idries Shah , [45] the series of novels also uses an approach similar to that employed by the early 20th century mystic G. Gurdjieff in his work *All and Everything*. Earlier works of "inner space" fiction like *Briefing for a Descent into Hell* and *Memoirs of a Survivor* also connect to this theme. She also regretted that critics failed to appreciate the exceptional structure of the novel. She explained in *Walking in the Shade* that she modelled Molly partly on her good friend Joan Rodker , the daughter of the modernist poet and publisher John Rodker. When asked why, she explained: They want me to bear witness. In fact, they do.
