Use everyday language and outline your plan, grouping similar ideas under the same headings. Edit your draft to remove all extraneous comments. Keep only the essential information and include numbers and statistics. Separate the information into categories with clear headings. Your market is the group of customers that are likely to purchase your goods and services. Include figures or charts that illustrate recent market trends, economic forecasts, regional demographics, regulations and any other substantial factor that is likely to affect the market for your product or service.
