You must include the year the name of the event and a title. This will be submitted at the end of class. Students will take notes during a presentation and complete a Cold War Alpha box that will describe the word or date. They will also complete a Cold War Vocabulary Chart. Students will also take Cornell Notes on this power point presentation.
