Thus proving the lack of necessity in swimming department in a Grand Theft Auto experience. Carried over with heist crews in V. First game in the HD universe to have a classic on-rail vehicle shooting segment. Made Strangers side missions immediately noticeable on the mini-map instead of requiring the player to be near the area. Carried over in each subsequent open world Rockstar game Potentially the last open world Rockstar game to offer multiple distinct methods in handling story missions. First game in the franchise that made us realize no matter how good or bad the ending is for our protagonist, it can always somehow get worst in a sequel.
