*The fifth volume in Ms. White's serialization of the Barbour Collection of Connecticut town vital records is a transcription of the vital records of the towns of Canaan and Canterbury, and it contains the birth, marriage, and death records of about 30, individuals.*

I have obtained permission from the Connecticut State Library to post this information at the Osborne Origins website. The Connecticut State library is not surrendering its own right to publish this material or to grant permission to others to do so. Please use this material with the same restraint as you would any other copyrighted material. I will be updating this page within a few weeks to include a list of the towns with the abbreviations I have used for them. This will make it a bit easier to search this list using `ctrl-F` of your browser for records from a particular town. I will also include a list of the abbreviations used for the record books. At the moment, the only such abbreviation I can identify is "LR" which stands for "Land Record book" -- i. In some towns the earliest vital records were kept in the deed books. This list is not yet complete! Because the rearrangement left some of the family relationships ambiguous, I have enclosed some of the data in " " to clarify the relationships. These numbers in "[ ]" also act as links to where they appear in the "Linked Family Records" -- click on the link and a family group where that person is a member will pop up. All other uses of "[ ]" in the list below are actually part of the information in the Barbour Collection. This case and also case 5 above is usually because the town records were recorded by family, for instance: March 1, and in this transcription of the Barbour Collection as: It should be noted that sometimes the transcribers mis-interpreted the abbreviation and then expanded the name incorrectly. If by chance the transcriber mis-interprets a name of one sex as being a name of the other sex, the sex information given in the Barbour Collection will be wrong.
