24 The Power of a PRAYING WIFE time went on, cute became irritating and perfect became driving perfectionism. I decided that what irritated me most about him had to be changed and then everything would be fine.

God has commanded us to be people of prayer, not only for ourselves, but for those in authority over us. Women are asked to submit to their husbands, respect them, and pray for them. The Bible says—Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing. Sarah was the godly wife of Abraham and followed her husband when God told him to leave his family and go to a place he would show him. Sarah was a beautiful woman even in her old age. Abraham and Sarah lived in tents for much of their lives and they sometimes were forced to go through some unfamiliar lands. During one of their adventures, they went to Gerar, and Abraham was brought before the king named Abimelech. Abraham was afraid he would be killed, so he told Sarah he was going to tell the King she was his sister. Sarah submitted to the plan, even though it meant she could be raped or taken from her husband permanently. She loved Abraham and trusted God would protect her. Abimelech thought Sarah was beautiful and quickly took Sarah to be part of his harem. God saw his beautiful daughter and was not pleased with what her husband did. That night he came to Abimelech in a dream and said, You are a dead man! Abimelech had not touched her yet and said, LORD, will you kill a righteous nation? Abraham told me she was his sister, and Sarah herself said, he is my brother. In the integrity of my heart I have done this. God said, I know that you did this with integrity in your heart; for this is why I have kept you from touching her. Now return this woman to her husband, for he is a prophet. When he prays for you, you shall live. If you do not return her, you and all of your house will die. Abimelech rose early in the morning and told all his servants what the LORD had spoken to him in the dream. They were very afraid. Abimelech called Abraham and said, What have you done to us? How have I offended you, that you have brought this great sin upon my kingdom? Abraham said, I thought the fear of God was not in this place, and I was afraid for my life. She is my sister, but not the daughter of my mother. Abimelech gave Abraham sheep, oxen, servants, and returned Sarah to him unharmed. He said, The land is before you, dwell wherever you please. Abimelech said to Sarah, I have given your brother a thousand pieces of silver. He is a covering for you. Abraham prayed for Abimelech and God healed the women in his house— for God had shut up all the wombs of the house of the king, his wife and maid servants, because of Sarah. They now could bear children with the blessing of the LORD upon them. How wonderful that God protected Sarah from being harmed. When a couple marries, they become one flesh. What God has joined, let no man separate. The nation would be cursed with infertility and lose the blessings and protection of God. All the people would die because one man lied and one committed adultery. How it must grieve the heart of God, when he sees all the marriages in the world being separated by infidelity and divorce. God instructs men— Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it. The stories in scripture are to warn us of the consequences of sin. God is omniscient and sees everything. God had a good plan for Abraham and Sarah, but they needed to turn from their sins and pray for the king and his family. God loves us so much he sent Jesus to fulfill the law for us perfectly. When we sin, he lovingly points out our mistakes and helps us get back on the right path.
