

Chapter 1 : Girls Tennis Individual State Tournament

These tournaments are primarily for players who have experienced success at the Sectional Championships, Excellence and Championship tournaments in their sections. It is important for players who want to play national tournaments to plan their schedules carefully because acceptance at some tournaments will rely on their national standings while others will rely on sectional rankings. Keep in mind that while players earn national ranking points in the national tournaments, they can also earn national points and sectional points by playing in the Sectional Championships and Excellence and Championship Tournaments held here in Northern California. To obtain a copy of the National Junior Tournament Schedule for , contact: Endorsement Lists shall include all players who are age eligible for play in the tournament for which the list is published. National Standings Lists are lists of the top ranked players in the country. The lists are published weekly and include all age-eligible players who have accumulated at least 1 national ranking point during the computation period. For information on the national points per round ranking system, refer to the National Junior Tournament Schedule. Selection for these tournaments is based on National Standings Lists. The names of these tournaments are: Generally, NorCal sends its strongest players who meet the minimum endorsement requirements listed below, but specific endorsement procedures will be published on the website. If you are interested in being on a team, contact Summer Verhoeven via email at verhoeven norcal. Be sure to let her know your current mailing address, phone number and email address as team event information and entry forms will be mailed directly to you. Players who have accepted an endorsement to a team event is obligated to inform USTA NorCal in writing immediately if they decide not to participate. All unacceptable or untimely withdrawals will be referred to the Sportsmanship Committee for appropriate action. All players are responsible for their own airfare and a coaching fee. Match results count towards a national ranking. Only Northern California residents may participate. Players are notified by phone and mail. NorCal sends a team of four boys and four girls. Each Zone Team Championship is run concurrently and hosts 12 boys teams of five players each and 12 girls teams of five players each; everyone participates in a non-elimination format. This is a four-day event and is held on a hard court surface. The total number of players is determined by the USTA and may be subject to change yearly. Entry is by sectional endorsement. Each Zone Team Championship is run concurrently and hosts 12 boys teams of five players each and 12 girls teams of five players each; everyone participate in a non-elimination format. This is a four-day event and is held on a clay surface. The four zones are Northeast, Southeast, Central, and Pacific. Each zone team championship is run concurrently hosts 16 boys teams of five players each and 16 girls teams of five players each; everyone participate in a non-elimination format. Each player shall have points added to their singles point total if the player has played three doubles events to completion that count for USTA NorCal doubles rankings between January 1 and the date of publication of NorCal Team Selection List. In order for a player to play a doubles event "to completion" they may not have withdrawn from the doubles event for any reason including default, injury, illness, or personal emergency.

Chapter 2 : Officiating Rules and Regulations

Any undefeated 1 doubles team in the regional team tennis tourney, whose team was eliminated, may enter the doubles tourney on Saturday, May Players having played the most matches in team tourney competition will receive preference for byes when possible. Pairings for the singles state finals shall be conducted in the following manner: The four players advancing to the individual state finals from the individual regional competitions will be the next placements. The individual regional champions with the greater number of individual matches won during the tourney team and individual will receive the better placements. No other data shall be used to determine pairings. State Finals " Doubles 1. Pairings at the doubles state finals shall be conducted in the following manner: The four doubles teams advancing to the doubles state finals from the doubles regional competitions will be the next placements. The doubles team regional champions with the greater number of matches won during the tourney team and doubles will receive the better placements. The doubles team shall be placed by a blind draw if there is a tie with the tourney records.
