The House of Mystery was built on this tradition but it surpassed its forbearers in the esteem of contemporary French critics. While Feuillade was sniffed at as trash, even the staunchest anti-serial critics were won over by the intelligence and skill with which this Albatros production was made. This serial can actually be compared to an acclaimed television miniseries. Still, it is genre-savvy and has many of the signatures of French serials: Over-the-top villainy, strong emphasis on the family unit and ridiculously tiny revolvers. It also has chases, escapes, fights and an honest-to-goodness cliffhanger. Well, when the Russian Revolution went the way of the Bolsheviks, a good portion of the Russian film industry skedaddled for France. The French welcomed them with open arms and they immediately set up shop. Albatros was their most famous studio. A talented band of performers and directors. They created wildly innovative movies that were both entertaining and intelligent. Would it live up to the very high expectations that I had built? This is where we find out! You had a bad week? As you can see, The House of Mystery is not one of those action-action-action kind of serials.
