*I found the Yarn Stash Workbook to be a good source of ideas for using up odd scraps of wool. If you are a knitter and have bags of oddments left over from other projects, then this is the book for you.*

I used Shweshwe, which is a traditional South African fabric. I used it because I love the designs, but more importantly, because my mom gave me these pieces of Shweshwe and when I miss her South Africa is so far away!! Just look at that beautiful fabric! Once my files were covered, I printed out some of these templates. I stuck a ball band at the top of each page some brands needed more than one page, because I have so many shades and then laminated the pages. This is not strictly necessary. If you print the template out on cardstock, you should be fine. But I like myself some laminating! I made sure that the care instructions were visible. For some brands, like the Stylecraft above, I had to cut the ball band into segments. Then I took a Heart Punch but you can use any punch you fancy, and made a little heart-hole on each of the dots along the side of the template. Oooh hearts and of course my mind was running away with possible uses for the cut-out hearts. And as I write this, I remember that I had actually wanted to take the hearts with to South Africa when we went to visit. When that was done, I took my ball bands and noted down the Shade Number and Shade Name of each colour. At first I attached the yarn by just looping it through the hole, like so: Unfortunately, all those dangly bits of yarn were very annoying so I took my crochet hook and turned them into shorter, more manageable chains.
