She is impossibly strong shown in various episodes and has rather large breasts for a 14 year old. Izumi never uses an honorific suffix -san, -sama, -kun etc. While this usually means the speaker is very close to the person, this could also mean a grave insult. Izumi uses it to show her contempt and complete lack of respect for him. As a result, Yoshitaka often places the more difficult and often pointless tasks on Izumi. Izumi was originally going to be the "normal" character of the series but she turned out to show violent tendencies towards Yoshitaka and became the "doll" of the household: Be it flipping her skirt or attempting to remove her bra, Izumi is constantly being harassed. Out of all characters, Izumi, is the one who drives the plot the most, being the subject of nearly every episode. While frowned upon in the West, in Japan, girls under 15 years of age sometimes as young as 11 or 12 who pose for photobooks are quite popular. Referred to as a gravure idol , or a Japanese idol and model who poses for photographs and videos, more well-known idols include Mao Kobayashi born in and Saaya Irie born in She even has her own fan club from her own school and other schools as well. Pochi likes cute girls and often tries to rape Izumi in the anime In the manga, he is actually more respectful of her, though still perverted. He strongly dislikes males. Pochi is often used to name reptiles as if they were domesticated pets such as pet dogs, similar to the name Spot in western society. Similarly, Pochi is the name of the pet dragon in Keio Flying Squadron. His given name is unknown. Upon hearing the rumors of Yoshitaka, he immediately approached the mansion to demand the return of Izumi and Mitsuki. All his attempts at retrieving Izumi and Mitsuki fail, usually when his wife, Mizuho, abruptly stops him. Sawatari is a lolicon pervert, although he wishes to "not be put in the same category. Sawatari is highly attracted to his two daughters in a perverted way seemingly stronger when the girls dress up. Through a series of contests, he was able to take possession of Izumi momentarily. In terms of personality, Seiichirou is also a lolicon uniform fetishist who loves peeping pictures and playing girl simulation games like Yoshitaka, but also is a crossdresser. Another clarifying quotation came from Moses: The Lord God said unto Moses: For mine own purpose have I made these things. And by the word of my power, have I created them, which is mine Only Begotten Son, who is full of grace and truth. And worlds without number have I created; and I also created them for mine own purpose; and by the Son I created them, which is mine Only Begotten. Therefore, in the beginning the Word was, for he was the Word, even the messenger of salvationâ€” The light and the Redeemer of the world; the Spirit of truth, who came into the world, because the world was made by him, and in him was the life of men and the light of men. The worlds were made by him; men were made by him; all things were made by him, and through him, and of him. Just as a well-educated musician can recognize the composer of a symphony by its style and structure, so a well-educated surgeon can recognize the creator of human beings by the similarity of style and structure of our anatomy. Individual variations notwithstanding, this similarity provides additional evidence and deep spiritual confirmation of our divine creation by our same Creator. It enhances the understanding of our relationship to him: The Gods went down to organize man in their own image, in the image of the Gods to form they him, male and female to form they them. So we honor Jesus as our Creator, divinely directed by his Father. Jehovah Jesus was Jehovah. This sacred title is recorded only four times in the King James version of the Holy Bible see Exodus 6: The use of this holy name is also confirmed in modern scripture see Moroni Listen to this intriguing dialogue from the Old Testament. Moses had just received a divine appointment that he did not seekâ€”a commission to lead the children of Israel out of bondage. The scene takes place atop Mount Sinai: Later, in his mortal ministry, Jesus occasionally repeated

this name. Do you remember his terse response to tormenting questioners? Note the double meaning in his reply: The high priest asked him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed? And Jesus said, I am. Another instance occurred when Jesus was taunted about his acquaintanceship with Abraham: Then said the Jews unto him, I quote from their written testimony: We saw the Lord standing upon the breast-work of the pulpit, before us; and under his feet was a paved work of pure gold, in color like amber. I am the first and the last; I am he who liveth, I am he who was slain. From the Book of Mormon we learn that this responsibility was foreseen before his birth: Picture him in your mind, kneeling in fervent supplication. Listen to the beautiful language of his prayer. Sense his feeling for his weighty responsibility as mediator: I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee. For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me. I pray for them. Comprehending him as our advocate-intercessor-mediator with the Father gives us assurance of his unequaled understanding, justice, and mercy see Alma 7: Immanuel Jesus was foreordained to be the promised Immanuel. We comprehend that distinction well when we pray to our Heavenly Father in the name of his Son, Jesus Christ, through the power of the Holy Ghost. And as we do so regularly, we honor our heavenly and earthly parentage, just as Jesus honored his as the Son of God. So Jesus was the Anointed One. Scriptures declare that Christ is the only name under heaven whereby salvation comes see 2 Nephi He was the Lamb of God see 1 Nephi Behold I have given unto you my gospel, and this is the gospel which I have given unto you—that I came into the world to do the will of my Father, because my Father sent me. And my Father sent me that I might be lifted up upon the cross. This atonement was begun by his appointment in the premortal world but was worked out by Jesus during his mortal sojourn. Prophets had so prophesied his advent for many generations. Remember that there is no other way nor means whereby man can be saved, only through the atoning blood of Jesus Christ, who shall come; yea, remember that he cometh to redeem the world. Listen carefully to this explanation from Jesus: For behold, I, God, have suffered these things for all, that they might not suffer if they would repent; But if they would not repent they must suffer even as I; Which suffering caused myself, even God, the greatest of all, to tremble because of pain, and to bleed at every pore, and to suffer both body and spirit—and would that I might not drink the bitter cup, and shrink— Nevertheless, glory be to the Father, and I partook and finished my preparations unto the children of men. Unitedly, working hand in hand, we shall move forward as servants of the living God, doing the work of His Beloved Son, our Master, whom we serve and whose name we seek to glorify. I repeat, this, my brethren and sisters, is the work of the Almighty.

E-mail My beloved brothers and sisters wherever you may be, my dear friends and associates in this great work, as you can well understand, this for me is a most solemn and sacred occasion. Humbly I seek the direction of the Holy Spirit as I struggle to share with you the feelings of my heart. If in the circumstances I speak unduly much in a personal vein, I hope you will excuse me. I shall then try to put the first person singular behind me. We have mourned in recent days the passing of our beloved friend and leader, Howard William Hunter, the fourteenth President of the Church and prophet to the people. His tenure in office was brief, but the impression for good that he left was tremendous. Mild of manner, quiet in his ways, he was nonetheless the man whose strong convictions of the truth of this work made him powerfully persuasive in his advocacy of the Christlike life. He suffered much in his body before he was finally taken from us on the morning of March 3, . More than twenty-five thousand men, women, and children passed by his bier as his body lay in state in the beautiful rotunda of the Church Administration Building. With measured step they came one by one, reverently and with love for the man they had sustained only a few months before. On Wednesday, March 8, , his funeral services were held in this historic tabernacle and broadcast far and wide. Those services were a fitting memorial to a man of goodness and greatness who now belongs to the ages. Our hearts reach out with love and sympathy to his bereaved widow and to his sons and their families, now spanning three generations. Brother Monson and I, who had served as his counselors, took our places in the Quorum of the Twelve, which became the presiding authority of the Church. Three weeks ago today all of the living ordained Apostles gathered in a spirit of fasting and prayer in the upper room of the temple. Here we sang a sacred hymn and prayed together. The presidency was then reorganized, following a precedent well established through generations of the past. There was no campaigning, no contest, no ambition for office. It was quiet, peaceful, simple, and sacred. It was done after the pattern which the Lord Himself had put in place. We have received from many people expressions of congratulations and confidence. These have come from members of the Church and from those not of our faith. To one and all I express my deep appreciation. I know full well that it is not the man whom they compliment, but, rather, the office. Yesterday morning members of the Church across the world met together in a solemn assembly. You raised your hands, without compulsion and of your own free will, to confirm the action taken by the Apostles three weeks ago and to sustain those called to serve. As you know, mine has been the special privilege to serve as a counselor to three great Presidents. I think I know something of the meaning of heavy responsibility. But with all of that, I have, during these past few days, been overwhelmed with feelings of inadequacy and total dependency upon the Lord, who is my head and whose church this is, and upon the strength of these good men who are my counselors, my dear Brethren of the Twelve, of the Seventy, and of the Presiding Bishopric, and of the membership of the Church throughout the world. I search for words to express the depth of my gratitude and my appreciation and my love. Years ago I gave a talk on the loneliness of leadership. Now for the first time I realize the full import of that loneliness. I do not know why this mantle has fallen upon my shoulders. I suppose some of you may also wonder. But we are here. I am of only the third generation in the Church. My grandfather as a boy was baptized in the summer of in Ontario, Canada. His widowed mother eventually brought her two boys to Springfield, Illinois. From there, my grandfather walked to Nauvoo where he listened to the Prophet Joseph Smith. When the exodus of our people occurred in , he was an eighteen-year-old youth of strength and capacity and faith. He was a skilled builder of wagons and a blacksmith. He was among those whom President Young requested remain for a time in Iowa to assist those still on the westward trail. He married in , and set out for this valley in the spring of . Somewhere along that wearisome trail, his young wife sickened and died. With his own hands he dug a grave, split logs to make a coffin, lovingly buried her, then tearfully took their eleven-month-old child in his arms and marched on to this valley. He was among those

How lovely you are, wherever you are, you precious children. I love the youth of the Church. I have said again and again that I think we have never had a better generation than this. How grateful I am for your integrity, for your ambition to train your minds and your hands to do good work, for your love for the word of the Lord, and for your desire to walk in paths of virtue and truth and goodness.
