These roads quickly began causing historians, civilians, and divers to imagine a long-lost civilization, no longer known to mankind. A small cadre of historians proposed that a Chinese fleet could have created the road while on a journey in the area. The eeriest thing about this road? An Ottoman cartographer and admiral, Piri Reis, had drawn and signed the map in approximately 1492. The map shows western Europe, North Africa, and the eastern coast of Brazil. The Piri Reis map also shows what appears to be the Antarctic coast which scholars believe was not discovered until 1820. One of the most accurate world maps of its time, the fact that the Piri Reis map has only survived as a fragment adds to its mystery. Stonehenge lies in modern Wiltshire in the southwest region of England. The strange circle of stones dates back to approximately 2500 BCE. Each piece of Stonehenge weighs about 50,000 pounds and each stone came from a location approximately 20 miles away. Clearly, building this monument in the prehistoric era was seemingly an impossible feat. Without even horse drawn carriages to move the stone, how did the people bring nearly 300 of these giant rocks so far? And once they got them to the Salisbury Plain, how did they arrange them? Stonehenge was only one of the many, many henges made at approximately the same time Avebury is the largest of the stone circles created in a similar manner, yet no one knows just what they were for. The most commonly held hypothesis is that the henges had something to do with a religious or spiritual ritual. Stonehenge was also the site of 63 burials. Some believe that Stonehenge may have had astrological significance, as it is aligned with the sunset during the winter months. As the people who built Stonehenge left no written records behind, we may never know just what it was for. Shroud of Turin Photo Credit: Wikimedia Commons The mystery of the Shroud of Turin has been debated for centuries. First exhibited in a small church in France in 1356, the shroud supposedly shows the image of Jesus of Nazareth. The shroud is frequently the center of controversy, with each side feeling strongly that they are correct about the artifact. In 1988, a carbon dating test was run on a small corner of the shroud, which resulted in a given date of creation between 1260-1390 AD well within a range to assume that it was falsely created around the time of its first exhibition. Believers point to the fact that the shroud was damaged by fire and mended in 1532, which could skew the carbon results. The Vatican has never taken an official stance on the Shroud of Turin, although various popes have supported its claim of showing the face of Jesus. The Nazca Lines Photo Credit: The Nazca lines, which take up about 500 square miles, create the shapes of a number of creatures, including a condor, a hummingbird, a monkey, and a spider. Over time, more and more images have been found, including a whale seen above, a spider, a set of hands, and a man. The ability to draw these precise shapes without any sort of aerial view of the area is nearly unbelievable. Modern historians believe that the lines could have served a number of purposes. They might have been part of an irrigation system. The images could have been fertility icons. They could have been meant as worship of the god that took their shape. In , the novelty brand Terror Vision announced that music from the program would be released as a soundtrack for the first time. All of the music was re-mastered directly using the original tapes. It was not successful. Format[edit] Unsolved Mysteries featured segments in documentary film style, with actors portraying the victims, perpetrators and witnesses. In the earlier episodes, the following message was related to the audience at the beginning of the program: This program is about unsolved mysteries. Whenever possible, the actual family members and police officials have participated in recreating the events. What you are about to see is not a news broadcast. The re-enactments and special effects are actual eyewitness accounts. While the show was in production, viewers were invited to telephone, write letters or, in the newer broadcasts, submit tips through their website if they had information that might help solve a case. The segments all involved actual events, and generally fell into one of four categories: Accounts of abductions , suspicious deaths, homicides , robberies , claims of innocence, missing persons and other miscellaneous unsolved cases where the suspects were either unknown or could not be located. Alternative theories of history including the theories that outlaws such as Billy the Kid and Butch Cassidy did not die as history recorded, that the Russian Grand Duchess Anastasia Romanov survived the regicide that killed her entire family, that the assassination of Louisiana senator Huey Long may have been an accident, that the assassination of Martin Luther King was in fact a conspiracy, and that Kurt Cobain may have been murdered. Updates[edit] Viewers were occasionally given updates on success stories, where suspects were brought to justice and loved ones reunited. The show itself has been credited for bringing increased attention to certain cases and thus allowing them to be solved. One episode featured a video of an arsonist filming an unidentified house being burned down while he was giving strange commentary. Once it had been featured on the show, viewers were able to identify the house involved, and two suspects were arrested. Karl Malden also hosted the show before Robert Stack took over full-time. Unsolved Mysteries was also one of the few prime-time shows of its era to appeal to fans of the supernatural and used effective special effects to enhance tales of the unexplained. The premise of this program was to try to give the unjustly accused a final appeal for help, with the debut episode taking an in-depth look at the Jeffrey MacDonald case. The program was canceled after only a few episodes due to poor ratings. The first episode aired in November of as an Unsolved Mysteries special. In early , Stack was joined by actress Virginia Madsen for hosting duties in an attempt to boost its female audience. Lifetime "02 [edit] Lifetime Television , which had been airing re-runs of NBC episodes since the early s, began airing new episodes in . Consisting of a mixture of new and old cases, these episodes were produced between that year and , and usually aired on weekdays between 11 a. The program ceased producing new episodes when Stack was diagnosed with prostate cancer in late ; the program would not resume production before he died of an unrelated heart attack in May . In , the show was removed from the schedule. During some shows, callers gave tips to the telecenter. When the show was in active production, the number was displayed on the bottom of the screen at the end of each segment. The show featured a new set, new logo, new music, and updates on old

cases. In addition, actor Dennis Farina became the new host, as Stack had died five years earlier. The show debuted on Spike on October 13, The existing segments were also edited to be shorter so the show could be expanded to present five cases in an hour rather than the four of the original program. Because the majority of the cases were now between 20 and 40 years old, the re-edited segments usually did not reference the years in which the events presented originally occurred.
