A cesarean se-ZAYR-ee-an section is one way that a baby can be delivered. Caregivers will do this surgery when you cannot have your baby through your vagina. Caregivers make an incision cut in your lower abdomen belly and into the uterus womb. The baby is delivered through this incision. Your C-section may be planned for the delivery of your baby. You may also have a C-section done very quickly in case of an emergency situation. If it is an emergency, you may already be in labor while caregivers are getting you ready for the C-section. If you are pregnant with more than one baby, or have had C-sections for past deliveries, a C-section may be needed. It also may be needed if your body is not moving through the stages of labor. This may place you and your baby in danger. A C-section may be done if your baby is positioned in a way that makes it dangerous to have a vaginal delivery. It may also be done for certain birth defects. It may be done if your baby is having heart rate changes or other problems during your labor. Problems with the placenta plah-SEN-tah , or afterbirth, can also require delivery by C-section. Keep a written list of what medicines you take and when and why you take them. Bring the list of your medicines or the pill bottles when you see your caregivers. Ask your caregiver for information about your medicines. Do not take any medicines, over-the-counter drugs, vitamins, herbs, or food supplements without first talking to caregivers. Your caregivers can find out if these medicines may not work well with other medicines that you are taking. If you are taking medicine that makes you drowsy, do not drive or use heavy equipment. Always take your medicine as directed by caregivers. Call your caregiver if you think your medicines are not helping or if you feel you are having side effects. Ask your caregiver before stopping any medicine. If you are taking antibiotics an-ti-bi-OT-iks , take them until they are all gone, even if you feel better. Write down your questions about your C-section delivery and having a new baby. This way you will remember to ask these questions during your next visit. Talk to caregivers about using birth control. Women may be able to get pregnant again shortly after giving birth. It is very important to get enough rest after having a baby. Try to nap when your baby is sleeping. When feeding your baby, rest him on a pillow over your incision area. Ask your partner, friend, or a family member to help with laundry, cooking and other chores until you feel better. Ask your caregiver if there are any limits on driving. If you work outside the home, ask your caregiver when you should return to your job. Vaginal bleeding may increase if you are very active after having a baby. You may want to try resting more if your bleeding gets heavier. Talk to your caregiver before you start exercising. Together you can plan the best exercise program for you. It is best to start slowly and do more as you get stronger. Exercising makes the heart stronger, lowers blood pressure, and keeps you healthy. Ask your caregiver if you should avoid lifting heavy objects for a time. What should I do about constipation? Constipation kon-sti-PAY-shun is a condition where you have hard, dry bowel movements which are difficult to pass. With constipation, you may have BMs less often than usual and a feeling of fullness. You may feel sick to your stomach, and have head and stomach pain. Do not try to push the BM out if it is too hard. Walking is the best way to get your bowels moving. Eat foods high in fiber and drink lots of fluids to make it easier to have a BM. Good examples are high fiber cereals, beans, vegetables, and whole grain breads. Prune juice may help make the BM softer. You may use fiber medicine or a stool softener to help make your BMs soft and regular. Fiber medicine and stool softeners can be bought at grocery and drug stores. How should I care for my breasts? Your milk should "come in" your breasts should fill two to four days after delivery. Before your milk comes in, your breasts may feel soft. When the milk comes in, your breasts may feel full and hard. Colostrum koh-LOS-trum is the "early milk" or yellow liquid that you can squeeze from your breasts after delivery. Colostrum is what your baby will drink during the first couple of days after birth if you choose to breast feed. Colostrum has fat, carbohydrates, protein, and other special ingredients in it that help keep your baby healthy. If you plan to breast feed, ask caregivers to show you the correct ways to hold and breast feed your baby. Ask caregivers for more information about how to care for your breasts whether or not you are breast feeding.

When should I expect my monthly period to return? You may start menstruating having periods seven to nine weeks after delivery, if you are not breast feeding. Your periods may be shorter, longer, heavier or lighter than before. You may not have a period for many months if you are breast feeding. You may not have one until you stop breast feeding. You can still get pregnant even if you do not menstruate during this time. Use some form of birth control every time you have sexual intercourse, such as both foam and condoms together. What should I do about my mood changes? You may have mood changes after delivery. These changes may be called "post partum depression" or "baby blues". Hormone changes, being tired, and feeling anxious and nervous about being a parent may cause these mood changes. Talk to your caregiver if you feel unable to care for yourself or your baby. Call your caregiver if you feel depressed very sad. Call your caregiver immediately if you feel like you may hurt yourself or your baby. What should I know about perineal care? If you were in labor before you had a C-section, you may need to take special care of your perineum the area between your legs. Keep your perineum clean to prevent an infection. Caregivers may give you a squirt bottle of warm water or special cleaning solution to use. Squirt the water or solution on your perineum after urinating or having a BM, and then gently dry the area. You may only need to use a gentle soap and warm water to carefully wash your perineum. Change your sanitary pad every time you use the bathroom. Do not have sex or put things like tampons inside your vagina until three or four weeks after your delivery. Wait until your bleeding stops. Plan which type of birth control you will use before beginning to have sex again. When do I expect my vaginal discharge to stop? You will have a vaginal discharge called "lochia" LOH-kee-ah after delivery. The lochia is bright red the first one or two days after delivery, and later turns a pink color. The lochia changes to a white or yellow color by about the tenth day after delivery. It is normal to have discharge on and off for six weeks after delivery. Use a sanitary pad rather than a tampon. This helps prevent a vaginal infection. The lochia should not have a bad smell. You have a fever. You are having increased vaginal bleeding and are soaking more than one sanitary pad every hour. Your bleeding lasts longer than one month after your C-section. Call if your bleeding becomes as heavy or heavier than a heavy period. Your incision is swollen, red, or has pus coming from it. This may mean that it is infected.

When I do that kind of thing, I tend to learn a lot. Anyway, here are the most important thoughts I had as I worked through the first section about 3 weeks worth of meetings. The free-climbing story During my grad school days, our church had monthly couples meetings in which the pastor would give a short devotional designed to encourage us in our marriages. That threw me, because it was the exact opposite of what I had come to expect. He would have emphasized how desperately the world searches for meaning and joy, and what dangerous thrill-seeking it leads them into. So I was left with this question, which really bothered me at the time: I finally decided that the simple truth is that every thing the world does always has some aspect or other which positively demonstrates the truth of the gospel and another aspect which contrasts with it. We should notice both, and then we should use whichever is relevant to the situation in which we find ourselves Colossians 4: If there must be a bias, let it be toward looking for the positive, as instructed in Philippians 4: I think we must be aware of the negative, but I would rather use the positive in most cases. Integrating Christianity into our entire lives Platt exhorts us to take what we believe about the gospel and think about everything in our lives in its light. We must get away from compartmentalizing everything. In my opinion, when our response to our culture is inadequately Christian, the problem is usually that we have not figured out how Jesus is relevant to it. Creation How do we integrate our understanding of God as creator into our world view? How do we counter the culture using that understanding? The answer most Christians at our church would give is to fight against evolution. The positive point is that if God is our creator, then there is a Great Storyteller for our lives. That is a beautiful thing to be able to honestly believe, and as Christians we get to! He designed us for his own purposes, and he has the right, not we, to say what we are created for. We are behaving irresponsibly if we just wander off script and try to write our own story. We have a responsibility, and can be held accountable, for failing to live up to our design. How do we integrate the understanding of the fall into our world view? The essence of the fall was that Adam and Eve claimed the right to determine right and wrong for themselves in complete independence from God. Platt makes use of this idea by focusing on moral relativism. He argues that anyone who rejects belief in God cannot consistently believe in objective moral absolutes. Setting aside that there are many people who think that they can believe in absolutes without being believers in God, I still think this runs the risk of missing the point. The moral absolutes approach minimizes these feelings of morality, by telling people they have no right as unbelievers to have them. Idolatry The study guide uses the second half of Romans 1 to explore the topic of idolatry. Platt defines idolatry strangely, though. I think I know what Platt means "he means that idolatry is when we look to those things in some ultimate sense that should be reserved only for God. Platt points out the obsession of the Athenians with whatever is new Acts I think this could be true, but I would like to point out that it is just as common to make an idol out of the old as in Mark 2: We should just be sure that people are willing to actually act on what they discover. We probably do need to challenge people to avoid that. Platt asked us to list some of the most important idols in our day. Platt considers four alternatives: When we counter, he says, we seek to redeem, not conquer. I think that is wise. When he talks about conforming, he finds fault with our desire to make the gospel appeal to the surrounding culture. The gospel, he says, is inherently offensive. I agree that there are parts of the gospel which will offend, but it is equally true that the gospel, if we present it correctly, speaks to deep yearnings in people. He is right, though: In fact the beautiful parts of the gospel usually are the same as the difficult parts. If we soften what seem hard in it, we at the same time dilute what is good in it. There is a difference between using culture to redeem people and redeeming culture. Platt shows how we can do the first: I think we can do the second, actually redeem the culture "not REDEEM it, in the sense of saving it, of course, but redeem it, in the sense of bringing something good out of it. We can bring about real, though somewhat superficial, change to the system. Deep changes are coming when Jesus returns. Just think about

how the church changed slavery or the treatment of orphans, for example, or the role it had in establishing democracy. We are all in the culture. If we want to counter and redeem it, then we have to live in it. Some Christians use movies, songs, and other cultural expressions merely as rapport-building gimmicks for the gospel. I think we must go further. We must allow ourselves to be moved by the movies and the songs, to find them meaningful, but to do so discerningly. Inception Platt asked us to think of a popular song, show, or movie, to analyze it to see what desires, needs, questions of values of popular society it expresses, and then to show how Jesus meets those needs. Here is my example. The movie Inception spoilers ahead has at its core the following problem: As a consequence, they begin to wonder whether real life is real. His wife, driven by her obsession with the question, loses all connection with her family and eventually dies because of it. He is faced with the same danger. At the very end of the movie, he spins his totem, which is a small top. If it falls over, it is supposed to prove that he is not in a dream. At the last minute, he looks up, sees his son out in the yard, and goes out to be with him, leaving the top still spinning. The camera closes in on the totem for a moment, and then the screen goes dark without letting the audience see whether it has fallen, leaving us in doubt ourselves about whether the final scene was a dream or in real life. Why did the movie leave the final question Were they still dreaming? Not just as a gimmick, I believe. I think it was to emphasize for us the emotional state of the protagonist. We can just live life. When that happens, we can get stuck in skepticism and doubt, or we can move on with life. Some people pride themselves on being unwilling to consider any belief in God that does not come attached to absolute scientific proof. When he does so, they should be open to it. This chapter prescribes instructions for Federal agencies to deposit domestic checks and cash. Section 12 U. C 90, , , a and 31 U. Section Definitions Agency or Federal Agency A department, agency, or sub agency in the executive, judicial, or legislative branch of the Federal Government, including wholly owned Government corporations. Over the Counter Channel Application Network OTCnet A web-based application that integrates check capture and deposit reporting functionalities in one system. OTCnet enables Federal agencies which receive OTC collections for checks and cash to prepare an electronic deposit ticket or convert the checks to electronic instruments for settlement. OTCnet Check Capture A process which enables Federal agencies to scan paper domestic checks through a check reader that captures scanned check information and sends it to OTCnet electronically. Section Inscription on Checks Remitters must inscribe checks to the order of the specific organization maintaining the account to be credited, not to the Department of the Treasury Treasury. The payee organization must be sufficiently identified to ensure prompt delivery. However, if a check is made payable to Treasury, the agency must accept and process it immediately. Under no circumstances should remitters make checks payable by name to individual officers or employees of the Federal Government. Section Record of Checks Received Agency depositors must keep records of checks received, including the following information: Section Making Deposits The deposit must reach the financial institution by its designated cut-off time. When creating an OTCnet Deposit Ticket, the agency must enter the voucher date which shows when the deposit is created , not the date the agency expects it to arrive at the financial institution. Agencies must not post-date the voucher date, even if they are going to mail or send the deposit by courier. Agencies should make copies or digital images of all checks. Foreign items drawn on non-US financial institutions and Savings Bonds. After being scanned, Treasury recommends retaining physical checks for up to 5 business days to ensure that there are no problems with file transmission, image quality, and processing of the checks. Checks should be safeguarded prior to destruction, and shredding is the method by which checks should be destroyed. In such cases, the agency will receive from the financial institution a photocopy of the Secret Service Form At that point, the agency must contact the Secret Service to find out if the surrendered currency was determined to be counterfeit. The agency must ensure that the financial institution processes an OTCnet Deposit Ticket for the amount of surrendered currency that the Secret Service determines is not counterfeit. See the Contacts section for more information. Agencies must hand-deliver the deposits to their designated financial institution, or hire a courier or armored car service to make scheduled deliveries. Except as provided in Section Agencies cannot make deposits at a Federal Reserve Bank.
