Like if there are 3 shapes in a box, then you have to drag the number 3 from bottom and match it. The app also offers a quiz option on the home page at the bottom of the screen. The quiz option will make you play random games out of all the available games and the game changes every time you finish one game. The Kids Preschool Learning Games app is pretty good and will definitely help your child in learning in a fun way. The games are simple to understand and play. The reward points can keep your kids motivated to do better each time.
