So we should expect that there would be ample guidance given in the Scriptures to enable us to handle the problems and questions which pursue us on every side. Here is another of those pockets of condensed wisdom which you find frequently throughout the pages of the Scriptures, both in the Old Testament and New alike, and which it is very unwise to hasten through. This kind of a passage must be gone through slowly and thoughtfully, and, therefore, I propose that we take ample time. I want to make these messages as practical and as helpful to as many as possible. The Apostle Paul, writing to his friends in Corinth, probably from the city of Ephesus, says. I, Paul, myself entreat you, by the meekness and gentleness of Christ -- I who am humble when face to face with you but bold to you when I am away! For though we live in the world we are not carrying on a worldly war, for the weapons of our warfare are not worldly but have divine power to destroy strongholds. The background of it is a challenge to the authority of the Apostle Paul by the Corinthians. That is not surprising for it is still going on today. There are many today who object strenuously to what he teaches. In certain circles we are told that the Apostle Paul actually changed the teachings of the Lord Jesus, and thus changed Christianity from a simple, easily understood message to a highly complicated theological treatise, difficult to understand and completely different in intent and content from that which was preached by Jesus. Something of that had already started in the early church. When these Corinthians had received letters from Paul, some were angered by them and resisted strongly what he had said. Specifically, as this passage reveals, certain Christians in Corinth were saying that Paul was, essentially, no different than anyone else. Paul was quoting them when he writes, "I who am humble when face to face with you, but bold to you when I am away. In other words, they were saying, he is simply another religious figure who is playing the old game of "power politics," so we do not need to pay any more attention to him than we would to anyone else who came in and tried to take advantage of us for his own purposes. This the apostle promptly and powerfully repudiates. He says, in effect, "This is not the case. You Corinthians are quite wrong. You have failed to recognize the fundamental change which occurs in a Christian. When a man becomes a Christian, something fundamental, something absolutely radical, occurs in him so that he cannot see things as he once did. Furthermore, you do not understand the radical difference with which an apostle who is, by virtue of his office, a model Christian, a pattern for others must face life. If you think that I act like other people, that my motives, purposes, and goals are no different than ordinary men and women, then you have fundamentally misunderstood the whole matter. The phrase, For though we live in the world we are not carrying on a worldly war, is actually, "For though we walk or live in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. Yet this is not exactly wrong. They are recognizing the close affiliation between what the Bible calls "the flesh," and "society" or "the world. What is the flesh? You who have been studying the New Testament for years know that the flesh is essentially inherited selfishness. It is what is basically wrong with human nature. It is the monkey wrench which was inserted into the machinery of humanity at the very beginning and which we all inherit from our ancestors. It is responsible for the fact that all of us began life with a taint, a twist in our mechanism. It is not very long before it is quite apparent that we are fundamentally selfish. You do not have to teach a baby to be selfish. You do not have to send him to a private school to learn how to be naughty, to resist his parents, or to be inherently selfish. This taint crops up in any individual no matter what kind of a background, exposure, or environment he is subjected to; it is in the bloodstream of humanity. This is the unpleasant fact which society constantly resists, which man does not want to face, but which the Word of God bluntly and clearly states. If that is the flesh, that tendency to evil in every individual, then if you put all these flesh-centered, flesh-governed people together into a society, you have what the Bible calls "the world. This, any observer of human life can see, pervades the world of our day; self-interest is back of everything. That is why the revisers

have substituted the word "world" here. In a sense, they are right. This is clearly the idea the apostle has in mind. He says, "We are not acting like other people. We do not operate from the same motives; there is something quite different about us. If you try to judge us on the same basis you judge others you are going to be very far off -- you will miss the point entirely. He says, "We live in the flesh, in the world of normal society, but we do not fight on those terms. We are not carrying on a worldly war. Philips puts it this way: The truth is that, although of course we lead normal human lives, the battle we are fighting is on the spiritual level. Philips The New English Bible puts it: Weak men we may be; but it is not as such that we fight our battles. The Apostle Paul is speaking not only for himself, but for all Christians. Remember that an apostle is a pattern Christian. He is what all Christians are supposed to be. And he says, first, we live in the world. Monastic life has appealed to many through the centuries. History is full of men and women who have retreated to quiet places and tried to shut away all the mundane prattle and care of life. Count Tolstoi, of Russia; Rousseau, of France; Gauguin, the painter -- all tried to run away from life. There are many who seek to do so yet today. What astonishes me is the number of Christians who have this attitude. There has grown up in our time what I call the "Bible-city syndrome," which attempts to create a Christian hothouse, an atmosphere which is thoroughly Christian from the womb to the tomb, and permits no invasion of secular ideas or forces. It seeks to insulate and isolate as much as possible the Christian from the world. This is basically unbiblical and sub-Christian because it is contrary to this clear word of the apostle, who says, "We Christians live right in the midst of the world. The Lord Jesus himself put it this way: It must be a crazy shepherd who would do a thing like that! Yet that is how radical is the difference between true Christianity and the false version so evident in many places today. This "Bible-city syndrome" is producing thousands of Christian dropouts today. I understand there is a group in this very area that is suggesting something of this nature in the mountains near here. I do not know the whole story and therefore I am not trying to judge it, but I would certainly be against a Christian isolation ward if that is what they have in view. It is thoroughly unbiblical. It is well expressed in the old hymn, Where cross the crowded ways of life. Where sound the cries of race and clan. Above the noise of selfish strife. We hear thy voice, O Son of Man. Many have recognized that Christians are to live in the world, but they go on to assume that a Christian living in the world must be like the world, that he must think like the world, that he must depend upon the thoughts, philosophies, ideas, and writers of the world, and draw all his arguments and his solutions to problem from these sources. If you judge me as doing this then you have not understood the Christian position at all. We do not use human plans and methods to win our battles. They are opposing the right enemy but with the wrong weapons. They are seeking to employ the weapons of the world, which Paul renounces; he repudiates them entirely. He says, "we do not war a worldly warfare, we do not use human plans and methods to win our battles. Well, you can hardly escape them today. They are on every side, in every newspaper, every magazine you pick up. These are full of approaches to the solution of human problems. They are all perfectly sincere, often characterized by tremendous dedication and zeal and commendable in the extreme; but they are worldly. They are of the flesh; they are limited. These weapons are power politics, action blocs, organized programs, demonstrations, boycotts, picketing; even violence and arson. Let us face some facts plainly. These are clearly worldly weapons, are they not? They are what would be suggested by any non-Christian who is confronted by these problems and is trying to find a solution, men like Saul Alinsky or Stokely Carmichael. These men openly, clearly, and unequivocally propose these kind of solutions, and you cannot blame them. That is all they can see; that is all they know to do; that is all they have confidence in. They cannot see beyond the material, the visible, the physical situation. Anyone who reads the New Testament sees that this is always the way of the world. Its solutions are fundamentally shallow and superficial, because they are essentially one-dimensional. I was interested recently to learn that there is a new book out, written by a secular writer, called, The One-dimensional Man. It is an attempt I gathered to come to grips with some of the social issues today. But even worldlings can see that their approach lacks something -- it is one-dimensional. Yet this is not what you have in the New Testament.

He was told of how the Black Soulstone was corrupting the Angiris Council, just as he planned. The stone was taking too long to sway the Council against humanity, so Malthael altered his plans. He was aware that Tyrael had found Corvus, which would make for a useful stronghold. Although its enchantments denied entry to non-mortals, Balzael believed Malthael would overcome that problem. The plan worked, and the Horadrim retrieved the stone. In Sanctuary, Malthael possessed one of the captive Templars, and killed the others that had been imprisoned with the man. Malthael used his powers to extinguish the torches of the cells and reap the souls of the other prisoners. He then moved down into the catacombs that would take him to Corvus. Though these roughly maintain his appearance, they do so with a darkened hue, and only make use of his whirling ring attack. Other than this, the Shades are of little threat, usually having some more Life than the average Revenant Soldiers. The final battle with Malthael occurs on a relatively small circular platform. There are two health wells to the west and east. The battle is divided into three phases. The following abilities are ones he uses during the whole fight: A charge that causes knockback, but the damage is low, if any. This ability is not too dangerous by itself, but it can and often will kick the player into Death Shrouds. A whirling ring around Malthael, causing heavy damage to anyone inside. Malthael is fully mobile when using that power, and has a chance to reflect incoming projectiles up to the point where said projectiles can actually damage the user if they do not avoid them. Malthael will summon clouds of mist that move slowly on the floor. Malthael will spawn them faster the more health he is losing. During Phase 2, Malthael will not use this ability. From time to time, Malthael flies up and lands in the center of the platform. While this is happening, the Nephalem hero will suffer from a chilling debuff. Malthael can and should be damaged while he stands in the center, an easy task for ranged attackers. For this phase, his Death Shroud and Soul Nova abilities are replaced with ability to summon minions and to invoke Skull Spiral: Malthael periodically summons a group of souls at the edge of the arena. They quickly spiral toward the center of the arena, from where they fly out toward the edges. These souls cause high damage should the player fail to dodge them. The damage they cause can be significant, especially with their teleporting. However, they do drop Health Globes when killed. In a cutscene, Malthael shatters the Black Soulstone and absorbs it into his body. This starts the final stage. Malthael will from time to time fly into the air and land in the center of the platform. From there, he will release a group of five red waves of flame, each creating a stream of fire damaging everything on one side of it. The waves fly in all directions except behind Malthael his facing is random. The sector behind him is the only place that remains clear, and the damage is severe. Here are my findings! This list has weapons that require DLC content. If you want to see the list for the original game, check out this post. If you played the previous Dragon Age games, you may expect Unique purple weapons to be the best, but that is not the case. The best weapons in DA: Although there are plenty of powerful unique items, they pale in comparison to crafted gear. Unique weapons are certainly very good, but their relatively low item level and lack of customization makes crafted weapons superior at higher levels. As long as you use the best grip upgrade, they will be just as good. For dual-wield rogues, the best dagger is the Stone Stalker Blade. Blade of Red Birth, purchased from the Black Emporium with a price tag of gold. For mages, the Encore Schematic Staff is the best weapon, because in addition to decent stats and upgrade slots, it has a chance to cast one of 3 unique buffs for your entire party: However, this schematic is difficult to obtain. You need to have Trespasser installed and then obtain the schematic by following a puzzle, and finally use the Golden Nug so that the schematic will be available during your next playthrough; otherwise, this staff is only usable during the Trespasser DLC. This staff can be purchased from the Black Emporium for gold. The best two-handed weapon is either the Chromatic Greatsword schematic or the Prismatic Greataxe schematic. I would say the sword is still better though, especially for Reaver warriors since they rely completely on skill damage Dragon Rage and Devour rather than basic attacks. In order to use the sword you need to complete the Fireworks Mini-mage in the Trespasser DLC, and use the Golden Nug to make the schematic available for your next playthrough. Axe of the Dragon Hunter schematic is the second-best two-hander. Unlike other high-level schematics, this one allows you to add a Haft and a Pommel to the crafted weapon, significantly increasing its stats. This axe can be bought from the Black Emporium for gold. Greatest Hits is the best tanking weapon in the game, thanks to its unique defensive buffs. Much like the Encore staff, it gives you a chance on hit to apply one of three buffs to you and nearby party members. The 3 defensive buffs are: This unique sword requires the Trespasser DLC. Truncheon of the Master is probably the next best alternative. This mace also requires Trespasser, and you need to have the new Trials options turned on to have a chance to obtain this weapon as a Trials reward. For another option, there is the Valos Atredum sword found in the Deep Roads. Location of the Valos Atredum unique sword "you have to jump down onto a hidden ledge and walk around the rock to find it. This schematic can be found as random loot in the Deep Roads. Finally for the standalone game your best best is the Shield of the Emperor. As a final note, acquiring these weapon schematics is only half the story. You then need to craft them with proper materials to get the best possible result. There are 3 key tips for crafting your weapons: If you run out, you can also purchase Tier 4 materials at the Black Emporium, in the Deep Roads, and some other locations. Choose the appropriate materials for your particular character. Extra crafting components like runes and weapon grips also have a tier system, so try to craft the best possible version to make your weapon even more powerful. Schematics for these are often sold by merchants or found in the game world.

She is called Athene in the Iliad and the Odyssey but after BCE the spelling of her name was changed slightly and she was thereafter referred to as Athena. She has various other names: She is also called Tritogeneia because she was raised by the Nymphs of the Tritonian lake [or river] in Libya. Athene is the guardian of cities She is the goddess of wisdom, craft, intellect and invention. She taught men how to construct war chariots and inspired women to engage in crafts which would make their homes more efficient and comfortable. She delights in battle and strides beside her stepbrother Ares [god of war] when she is not fighting against him. The Birth of Athene Zeus took the goddess Metis as his first wife and she soon became pregnant. Being fearful and prudent, Zeus swallowed Metis and in the vastness of his being, the goddess Athene was born. Metis gave her daughter weapons and clothed her in armor Helios [Sun] halted his chariot in the sky, the earth shook and the sea tossed violently as the fierce goddess stood defiantly before the astonished Immortals. Finally, Athene stripped off her armor to reveal her elegant feminine form and divine beauty Helios began to move through the sky once more and the troubled sea became quiet. Athene is one of only three goddesses who can resist the love charms and spells of Aphrodite. Hestia and Artemis are the other two. Hestia is goddess of the Hearth and Artemis is goddess of the Hunt. Hera cursed Zeus and swore a bitter oath that she would spite him with a child of her own that would be as repugnant as Athene was perfect. Hera conceived, without consort, the monstrous snake-bodied thing named Typhaon. To add to her humiliation, when Zeus and Hera argued over Hephaistos, the young god was thrown from Mount Olympos and severely injured his legs when he finally hit the earth. From that time on, Hephaistos was lame and therefore Hera did not consider him to be a worthy son for the queen of the Immortals. Hera blamed Athene as much as Zeus for the embarrassment Hephaistos caused her. Since Athene was a chaste goddess and did not compete on the battlefield of love, Hera came to appreciate the young goddess for her cleverness and fierceness. The two most notable collaborations between Hera and Athene were in assisting Jason and the Argonauts in their Quest for the Golden Fleece and assuring victory for the Achaean Greeks in the Trojan War. The dispute which arose involving Prince Paris at first pitted the two goddesses against one another but eventually united them against the goddess of love, Aphrodite. Athene and Pandora At the dawn of time, mortal men lived without mates on the cruel and pitiless earth. The first woman was created as a gift and punishment to mankind. The actions of the god Prometheus indirectly caused this incredible event. Prometheus is the son of the Titans, Iapetos and Klymene. Although he fought for Zeus and his siblings so that they could become the Olympians and thus the ultimate deities, he still disagreed with the way the mortal men on the earth were being treated. In direct defiance to the command of Zeus, Prometheus gave men fire. Zeus was outraged and had Hephaistos shackle Prometheus to the side of a crag, high in the Caucasus Mountains. Athene taught Pandora the skills of weaving and gave her dexterity. Aphrodite put a mist upon her head to engender longings and desire. Hermes gave her treachery and shamelessness. When Epimetheus accepted Pandora he unleashed all the evils on the world. The only positive influence that Pandora brought to the world of men was Hope. Athene and Herakles Even the greatest hero of all times needed a protector. Athene simply made the tragic and difficult life of Herakles a little less painful. The Labors of Herakles The goddess Hera hated Herakles and devised a series of hardships to torment the hero. Herakles was the son of Zeus and a mortal woman named Alkmene When Hera learned that Alkmene was pregnant, she tricked Zeus into promising that the next son to be born in the bloodline of Perseus would rule Argos. Zeus was sure that Herakles would be that son but Hera delayed Eileithyia, the goddess of Childbirth, from attending Alkmene and allowed a man named Eurystheus to be born before Herakles. Herakles was later bound to Eurystheus and required to perform the labors which have become known as the Twelve Labors of

Herakles. Athene assisted Herakles in six of his Twelve Labors: The Hydra had a huge body with eight mortal heads and one immortal head. The creature lurked in the swamps of Lerna, which was a marshy region near ancient Argos in southeast Greece on the Peloponnesian Peninsula. The Hydra was very hard to kill because each time one of the serpent-like heads was hacked off, two new heads grew to replace it. Also, the blood of the Hydra was a deadly poison. With the help of his cousin Iolaos He used either a sword or a sickle to hack at the heads while a giant crab, sent by the vengeful Hera to distract him, snapped at his heels. To prevent the heads from growing back two-fold, Herakles succeeded in cauterizing the squirming necks with fire as he cut off each head. To be rid of the deadly wild boar that was menacing the countryside around the mountain, Eurystheus commanded Herakles to capture the beast and deliver it to Mykenai alive With the help of his protector, Athene, he diverted the rivers Alpheios Labor Number 6 - Killing the Stymphalian Birds - Herakles was sent to kill the Stymphalian Birds either because they were a nuisance or, as later writers profess, because they were man-eaters. Herakles entered the woods around the lake near Stymphalos with his bow and a pair of krotalas They grew in a garden which was cultivated by three Nymphs collectively known as the Hesperides [Aegle, Erytheis and Hespere]. Atlas, a brother of Prometheus, stood on a mountain in northwestern Africa and supported the heavens on his shoulders. Atlas agreed to retrieve the Golden Apples from the Hesperides if Herakles would assume his burden and hold up the sky until he returned with the apples. The metope from the Temple of Zeus at Olympia shows Herakles with the sky on his shoulders while Atlas stands before him placidly offering the Golden Apples One of the sons of Ares named Kyknos Zeus dispatched Herakles to kill Kyknos As Herakles was preparing for the fight with Kyknos, Athene stood in front of his chariot and gave the hero a stern warning After Kyknos was laying dead in the dirt, Ares charged at Herakles Athene told Ares to back away but the war god was too furious to listen to reason Herakles did not back away from the fierce attack Ares fell flat upon the ground. He was the eldest son of Neleus and Chloris, and one of the Argonauts who sailed to retrieve the Golden Fleece. Periklymenos could transform into an eagle, an ant, a swarm of bees, a snake or any other form. Herakles came into conflict with Periklymenos in a rather sad and roundabout way. Herakles committed many atrocious acts in his life and one of them involved the murder of a man named Iphitos In a fit of rage, Herakles killed Neleus, Periklymenos and his brother Chromios. Alkmene looks down helplessly as an infant Herakles fights the snakes that Hera sent to destroy him. The two goddesses worked closely together so that a seemingly impossible task could be accomplished and become known as one of the most remarkable adventures of all time. The primary mortal characters in the Quest were: Pelias - the king of Iolkos Aeson - the father of Jason Jason - the rightful heir to the throne of Iolkos Aietes - the king of Kolchis Medeia - a princess of Kolchis Pelias usurped the throne of Iolkos and made Aeson an outcast in his own kingdom. Aeson sent his infant son Jason into hiding so that Pelias could not harm him but when Jason became a man, he returned to Iolkos to claim the throne which was rightfully his. Pelias said that he would relinquish the throne if Jason would go to the distant land of Kolchis and retrieve the Golden Fleece. From the very beginning, Hera was involved in orchestrating the Quest because of her love of Jason and also because she wanted to punish Pelias for his disrespectful behavior towards her. A ship was built and the finest young heroes in Greece joined the crew, some of the heroes came at the bidding of Athene. The ship was called the Argo, meaning Swift. The Argo was inspired by Athene and constructed by a man named Argos to be the most magnificent and seaworthy ship ever built. The keel of the Argo was made of oak which Athene cut in Dodona and endued with a human voice. The crewmembers of the Argo were called Argonauts, i. As vital as the Argo was to the Quest, Athene also gave Jason a wondrous shield to protect him and then drifted down on a cloud and into the sea to speed the Argo on its way. The Argo soon reached the Clashing Rocks which were two gigantic rocks the size of islands. When any ship attempted to pass between the rocks, they would clash together and crush it. When the Argo tried to sail between the Clashing Rocks, Athene held one of the rocks with one hand and pushed the ship safely through with the other. They decided to enlist the help of Aphrodite and hesitantly approached the goddess of love. Eros obeyed Aphrodite and shot Medeia with an arrow that infused her with an irresistible love for Jason. The voyage back to Iolkos was not an easy one. Athene and Hera repeatedly helped calm the seas and inspire other Immortals to assist the Argonauts. When the Argonauts were stranded in the Libyan desert, the Nymphs of the desert helped them because they had once helped

Athene when she had been born by the waters of nearby Lake Tritonian. Before reaching home, the Argonauts built a shrine to Minoan Athene on the island of Crete to show their appreciation for all the help the goddess had given them during their perilous journey. The Judgment of Paris The Immortals all have a common heritage and it would seem that they should also share common goals and values. The actuality of the situation is quite different from the ideal. Meanwhile, the usual suspects in the US and Western corporate press continue to fan the flames of a new cold war with Russia. Petersburg, according to an announcement by Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov. President Trump ordered the expulsion of 60 Russian officials from the United States and the closing of the Russian consulate in Seattle. The move follows the alleged poisoning of former Russian spy Sergei Skripal and his daughter Yulia in the English city of Salisbury on March 4. Joining us is someone who knows a great deal about the matter and has come under fire for taking an oppositional position, former UK ambassador, author and activist, Craig Murray. Murray, everyone says the Russians did it, no doubt about it, but you disagree. We are not supposed to assign responsibility for crime in this way, saying there is a bad guy in the neighborhood and therefore it must be him. So far, there has been no real evidence at all that it was the Russian state that did it. I find it remarkable that the very day this happened the British government was announcing that it was the Russian state that was behind this. This is coming out of the European Union today: The lives of many citizens were threatened by this reckless and illegal action. They say that the poison is consistent with what the Russians have used in the past. The claim is that this is one of a group of nerve agents known as a Novichok. The idea was to develop chemical weapons which could be quickly put together from commercial pesticides and fertilizers. They came up with a number of theoretical designs for such weapons. Until now, the official position of the British government and the Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons was that there was doubt as to whether they actually produced any of these. Novichok is not a particular weapon but a class of weapon. Russia is by no means the only country capable of producing this kind of weapon. In , the Iranians succeeded in producing several Novichok weapons and they reported their results to the Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons. Their motivation was that they were concerned that they themselves might be attacked by chemical weapons, possibly from Israel. There are at least a couple dozen countries who have the technical capability to create this type of nerve agent. In order to take blood samples from the Skripals, who were both in a coma, doctors had to get court approval. The British government has been telling us that this is ten times more powerful than a standard nerve agent. Thankfully, so far, nobody has been killed. Why is it that the doctor who administered first aid to Yulia Skripal was completely unaffected, even though he had extensive physical contact with her? But some people will say that the only country that would want to silence a former Russian spy would be Russia. Our foreign secretary, Boris Johnson, has gone on record as saying that the Russians have been secretly stockpiling this chemical weapon for a decade and have had a secret program of assassination techniques. But if you were Vladimir Putin and you had this secret nerve agent, why would you blow your cover by using it on this retired spy who you released from prison years ago? The whole scenario is utterly implausible. Why would Russia wish to ruin its international reputation with this entirely gratuitous violence against an old spy? Skripal was exchanged as part of a spy swap. A KGB person like Putin is the last person who is going to destroy the system of spy swaps. Murray, there has been a concerted effort to defame you and undermine your credibility. What effect has this had on you and your family? It has been really quite unpleasant. The mainstream media has permitted no doubt at all. All of them are just printing government propaganda. I went on social media to post my doubts about this story being too convenient and too easy. That brought upon me the wrath of the establishment. I became the recipient of hundreds of pieces of Twitter abuse in which I was called a nut and a conspiracy theorist. Who stands to benefit from this attack? It adds fuel to the new Cold War. The armaments industry are the primary people who benefit. This kind of thing is very good for defense budgets. It is very good news for

the spies and security services. Here in the UK the industry employs over , people. In a country of 60 million, this is a strong and very highly paid interest group. All of these people are seeing a major ramping up of their budgets. When the people feeding-in the intelligence are the same people who are benefiting financially from that story, then you have to worry. And particularly for right-wing politicians this is a cheap way of getting support. I can promise you that what came out of the DNC were leaks. They were from somebody who legally had access to the information. It was not an outside hack, not by the Russians, not by anyone. What if you were subpoenaed before Congress, would you take the fifth or would you tell that story? If called, I would turn up and I would gladly tell them what I have told you: I would not give any further details because that might compromise others. The guy who was responsible for handling Skripal on a day-to-day basis was Pablo Miller. Pablo Miller also worked for Orbis Intelligence. The MI6 has never had the close-up access to Putin that that dossier claims to have. Plainly, a great deal of it is fabrication. I strongly suspect that Mr. Skripal was involved in the production of that dossier about Donald Trump. I admit that this is circumstantial, but that dossier was produced while Pablo Miller was working for Orbis Intelligence. And Pablo Miller was also living in Salisbury, within a short distance of Skripal. If you are going to produce a dossier which invents a lot of stuff about Donald Trump and his connections to the circle around Putin, you need a Russian source who can give you names and lend the dossier a degree of authenticity. I believe that that kind of detail is what Skripal provided to the Steele dossier. This would seem a much more plausible lead in investigating this case. The idea that you kill someone for something that happened twelve years ago is frankly much less compelling than something that is happening now. The other possibility is that Mr. Skripal was a double agent who worked for money. He sold to the British names of Russian officers and agents serving abroad. So he is not the most principled of people. And if Skripal knows that this dossier is full of lies, he might come out and confess to fabricating all of this in hopes of making financial gain. You feel that you are under attack for taking this position? Yes, and it is not just the nasty tweets and emails. My website has been under attack, at a rate of millions of hits per minute. Have any of the mainstream media in Britain reported anything other than the government line? That was the end of that. You have been attacked by foreign minister Boris Johnson. Are you concerned that this might be leading to nuclear war? I think that the Russians have the sense not to overreact. All they have done so far is to match what is done rather than up the ante. So when we expelled 23 diplomats, the Russians expelled 23 diplomats. And it looks like this sort of tit for tat will result from the other expulsions. But I strongly believe that this is happening because there are a lot of peopleâ€”in the military, in the weapons industryâ€”who miss the Cold War. They are seeing a threat to their budgets. We are entering a period where there is not going to be a lot of international cooperation and we are going to see a lot of militaristic posturing. Of course, there is always the prospect that something can go wrong. This is someone who has said that he would be happy if North Korea disappeared. I think it is very scary. Bolton obviously is the hawk of hawks and he bore a huge responsibility for the Iraq War. It is a very strange and irresponsible appointment.
