Muttering under his breath, he ran frantically over the bridge. The word order within a sentence can be changed. In this example the adverb has been moved to the beginning. Frantically, he ran over the bridge, muttering under his breath. This time, the preposition has been moved to the beginning. Over the bridge he ran, muttering under his breath. In this example the adverb has been left out. Different effects are created by changing sentences in these ways. In general, the first part of the sentence has the greatest impact on the reader, so it is worth thinking about the effect you are trying to achieve when you construct your sentences. Be sure to do the Sentence Structure Quiz at the end of all the worksheets. Run-on Sentences A run-on sentence is two or more complete thoughts that are not correctly separated. It is the opposite of a fragment. While a fragment is only part of a complete thought, a run-on is too many complete thoughts written as one sentence. Here is an example: The sun was very hot we decided to sit in the shade. When two or more complete thoughts are joined without any punctuation or with the wrong punctuation, the result is a run-on sentence. There are two types of run-on sentences. One type is made up of two sentences that are not separated by punctuation. The storm got worse it turned toward the land. The storm got worse. It turned toward the land. The Japanese subway is the fastest train it travels over miles per hour. The Japanese subway is the fastest train. It travels over miles per hour. The other type is made up of two sentences joined with a comma when they should be joined with a semicolon or a comma and a connecting word. This type of run-on is sometimes called a comma splice. We were not hungry, we had already had lunch. We were not hungry; we had already had lunch. You can visit the White House, you can tour many rooms. You can visit the White House, and you can tour many rooms. Put a check next to the sentence if it is a run-on. Bacteria in food can cause illness you should take care to store food properly. Hamburgers should be eaten well done, cooking kills bacteria. Raw eggs are not safe to eat they may contain salmonella. You can use soap to clean the kitchen counter, but bleach is better. How to Correct Run-on Sentences There are three main ways to correct a run-on sentence. Here is a run-on sentence that we will correct all three ways: Separate the two sentences with a period. I must need a new battery. Separate the two sentences with a semicolon. When you use a semicolon, the next word is not capitalized. Sometimes you may want to use connecting words with your semicolon. Connectors are words like: When you use these words, be sure to put a semicolon before them and a comma after them. You can review the Punctuation Worksheet for more practice with these. Separate the two sentences with a comma and a coordinating conjunction. Always use a comma with these words. Some sentences may have more than one correct answer.
